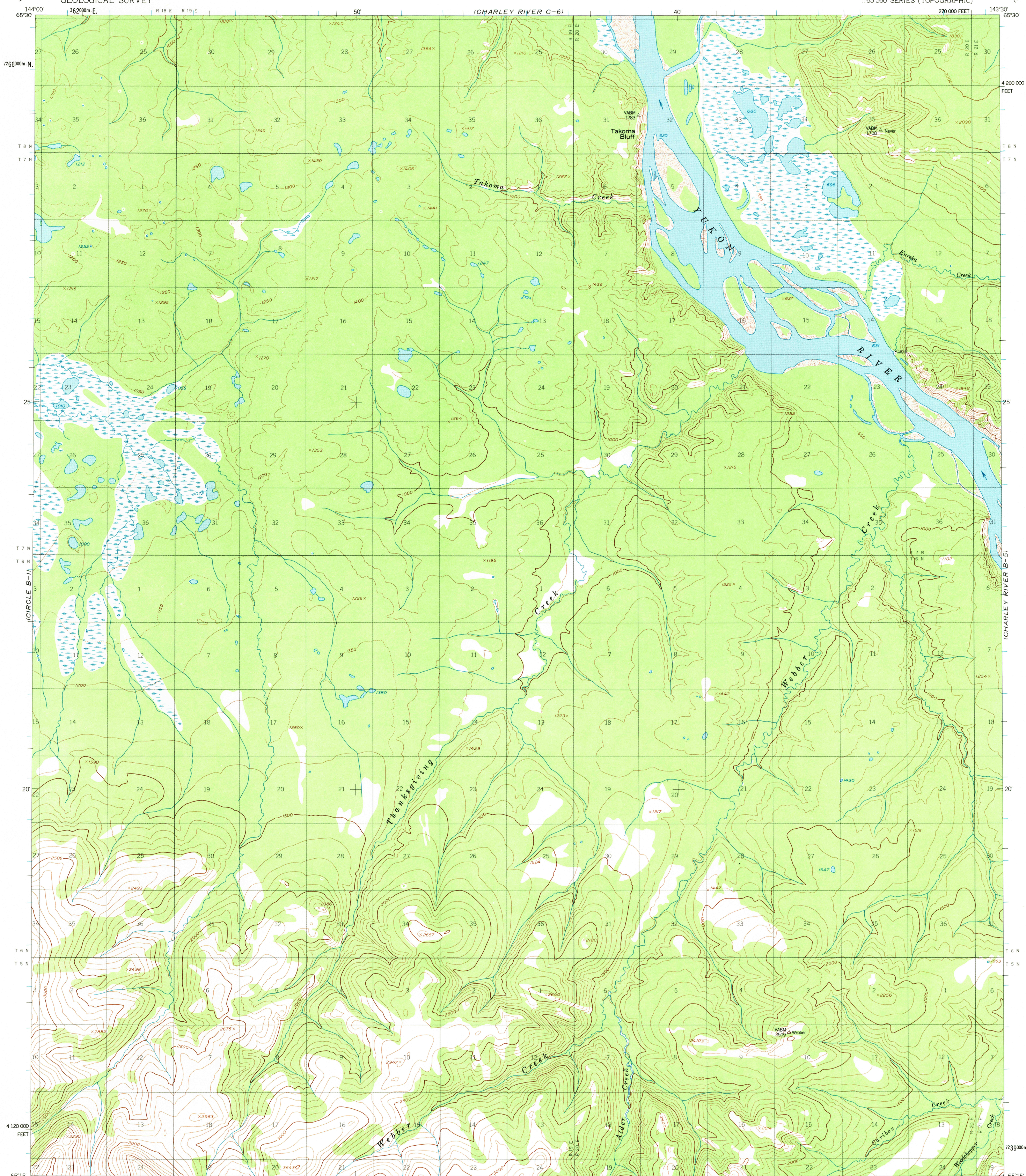

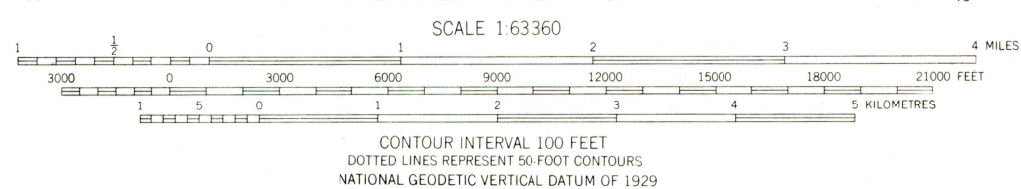
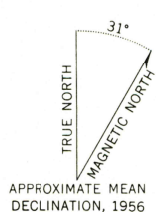
CHARLEY RIVER (B-6) QUADRANGLE
