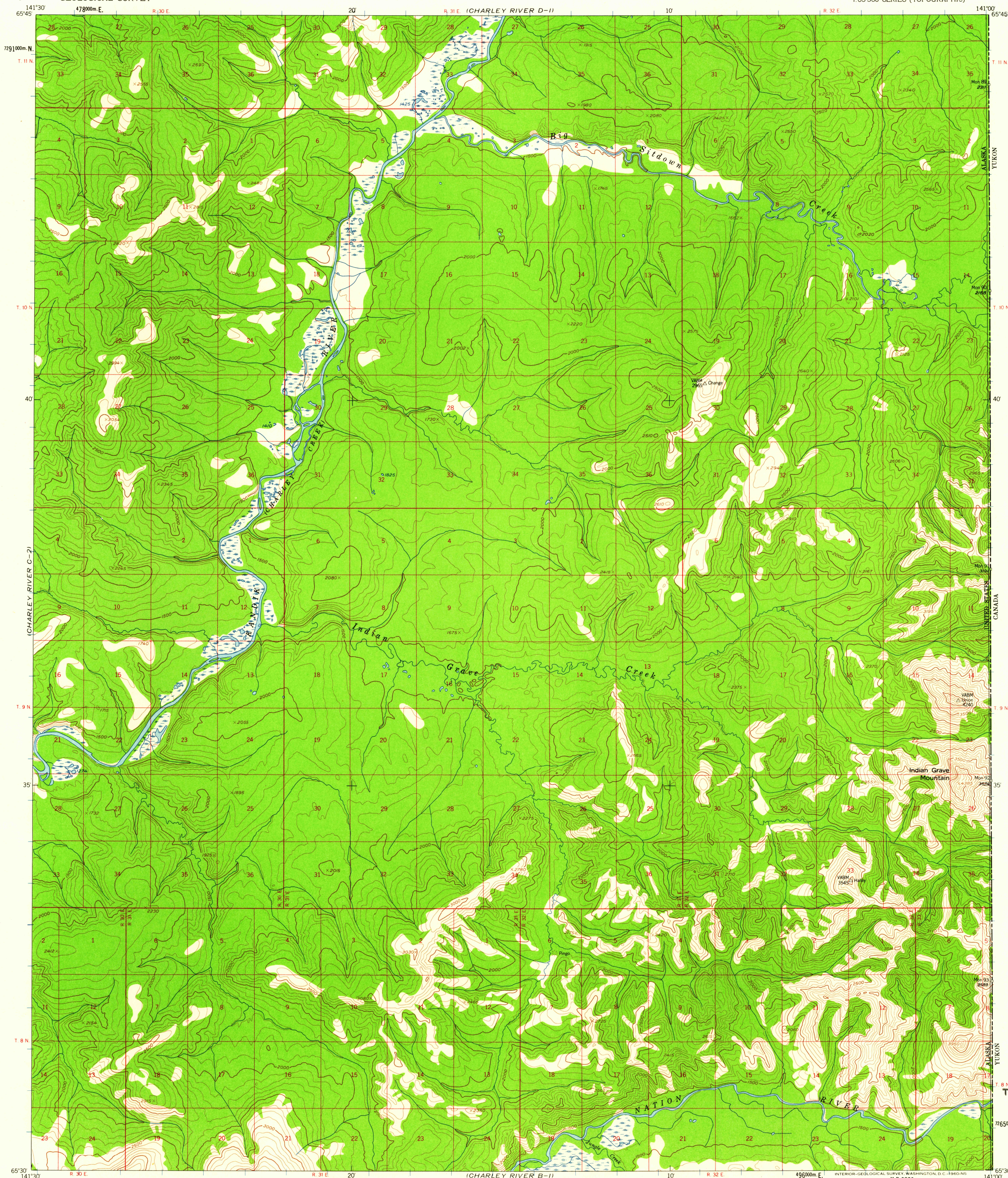

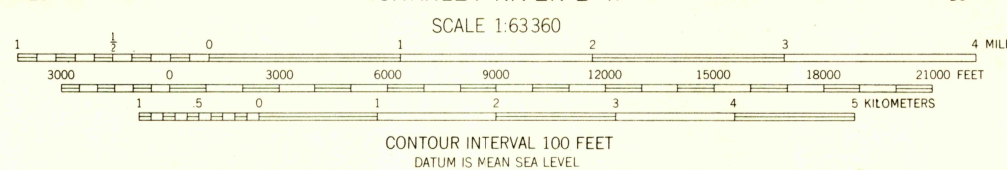
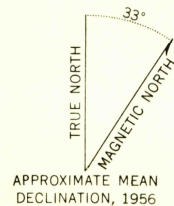

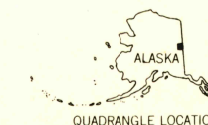
Universal Transverse Mercator projection
