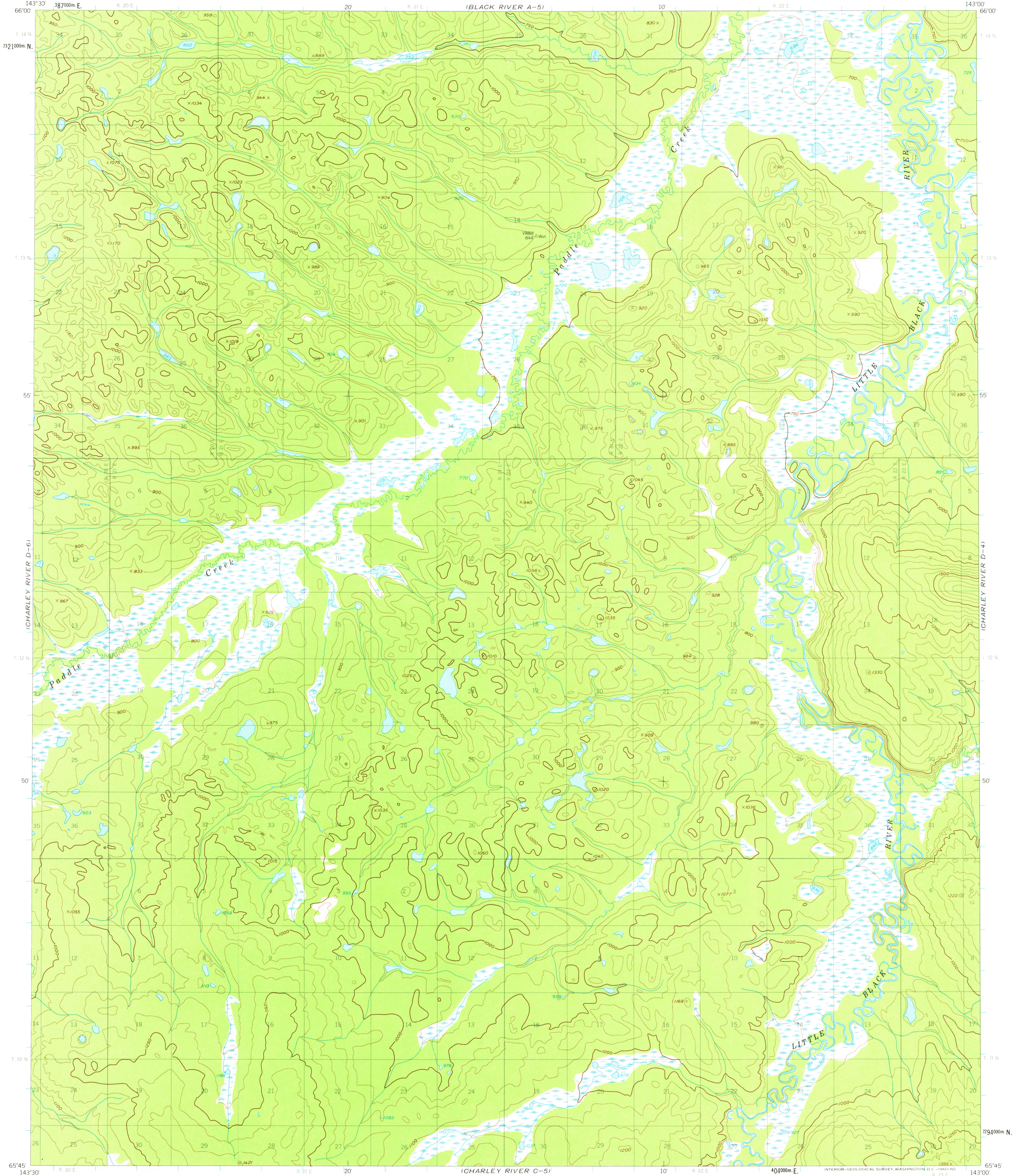

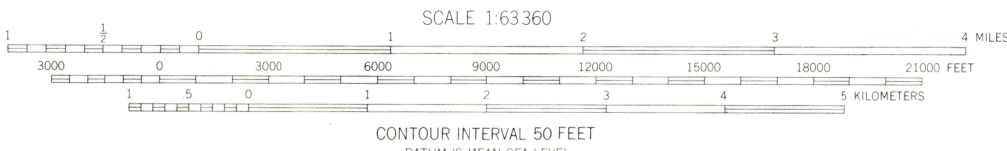
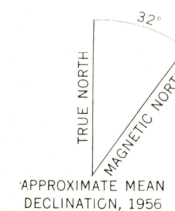
CHARLEY RIVER (D-5) QUADRANGLE
