predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management

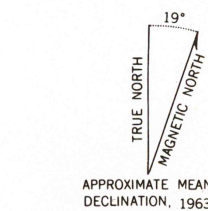

usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs

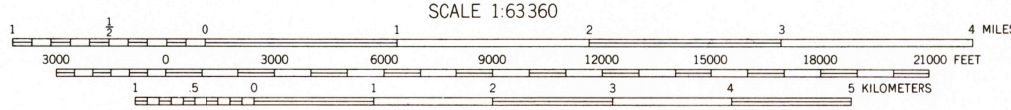
Federal reservation boundaries established by The Alaska National
