

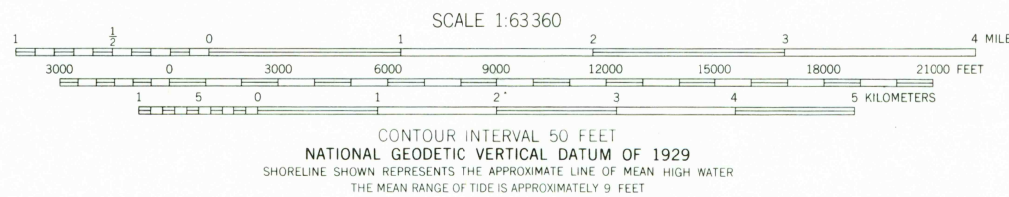

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations
predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management,
Folio S-27, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 95 meters north and 134 meters east
The Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge consists of
all public lands in the coastal waters and adjacent seas of
Alaska consisting of islands, islets, rocks, reefs, capes and spires
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
