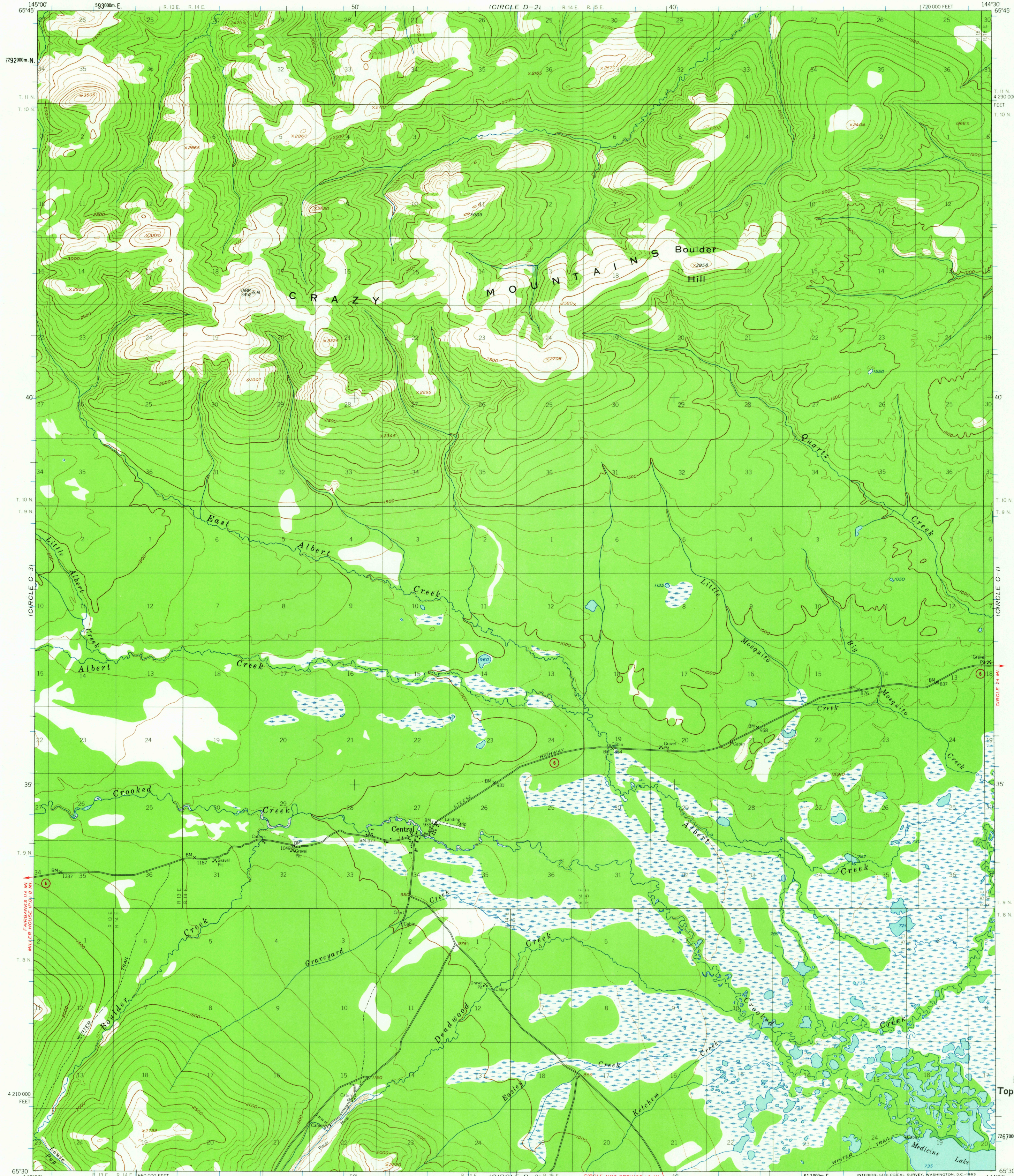

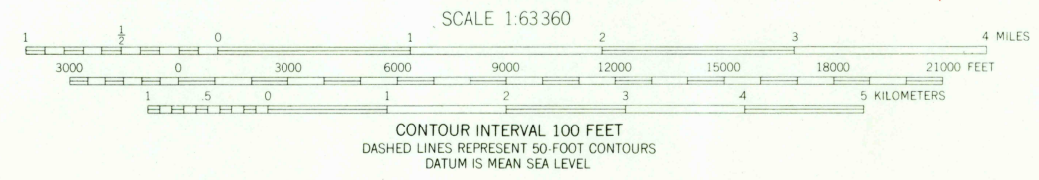
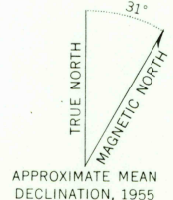
CIRCLE (C-2) QUADRANGLE
