

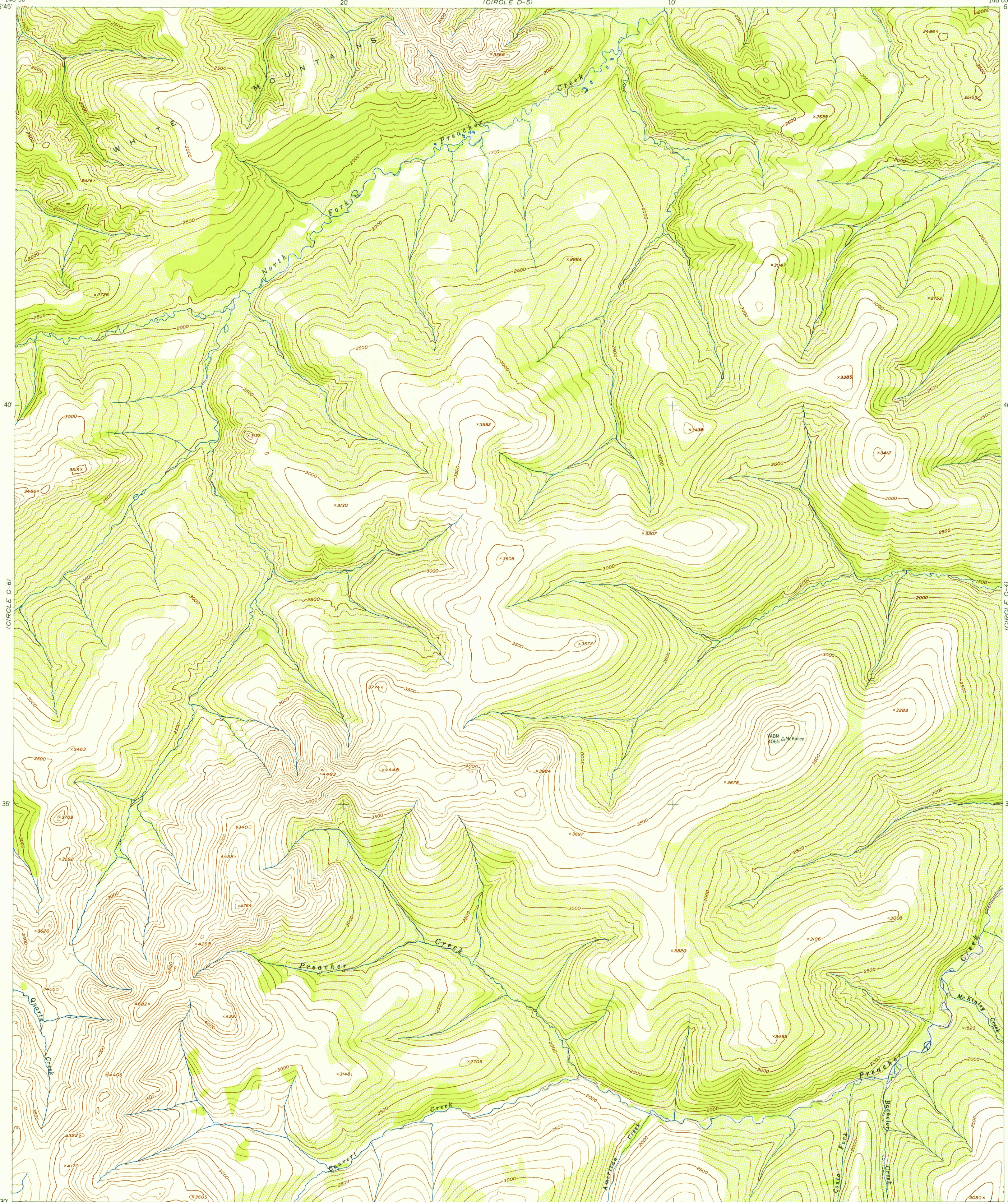

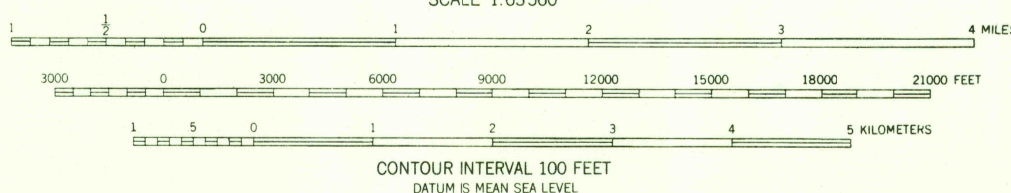
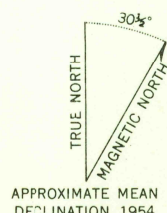
CIRCLE (C-5) QUADRANGLE
