the projection lines 44 meters north and 115 meters east

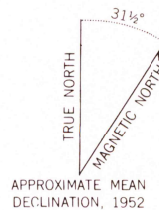

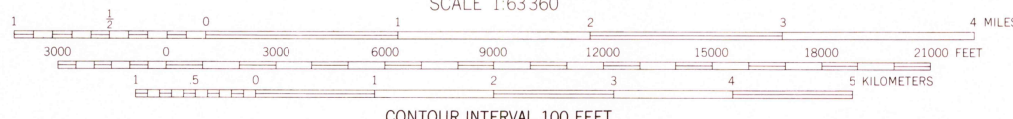

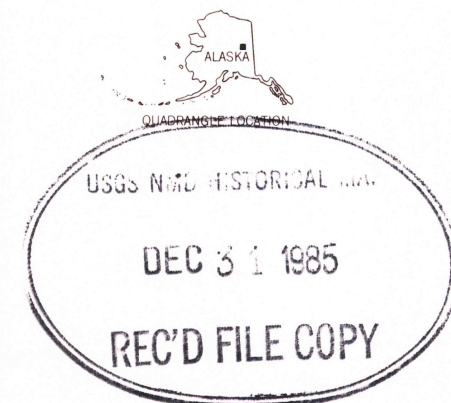
APPROXIMATE MEAN
