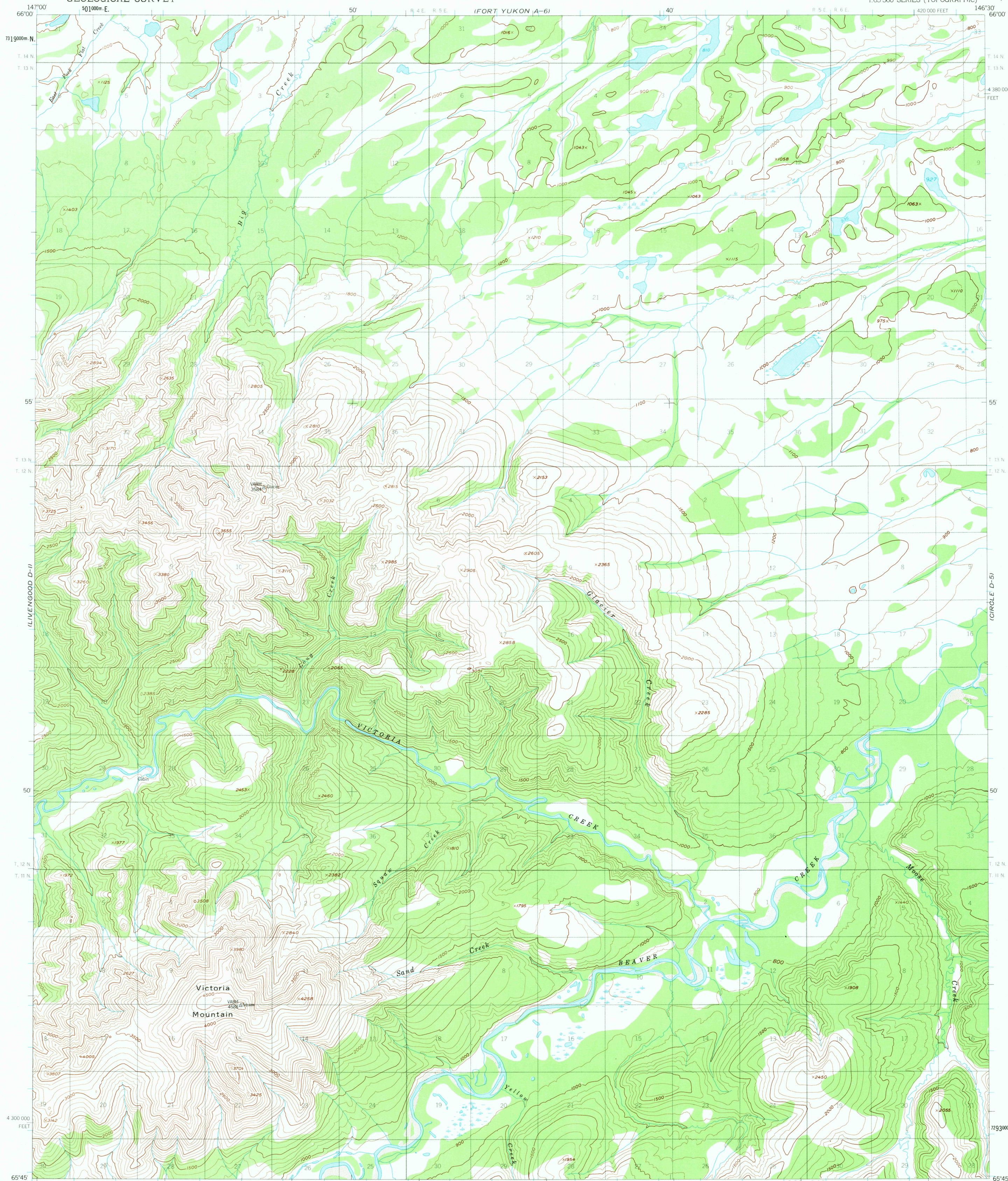

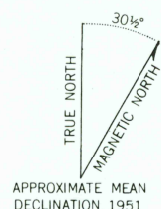

Folio F-7, Fairbanks Meridian

Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 46 meters north and 116 meters east
