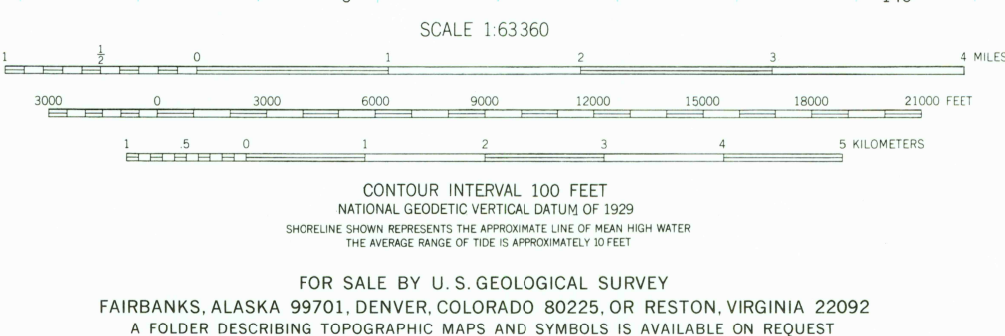
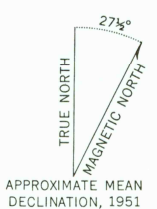
CORDOVA (B-6) QUADRANGLE
