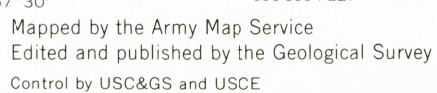


DILLINGHAM (B-4) QUADRANGLE

1:63 360 SERIES (TOPOGRAPHIC)

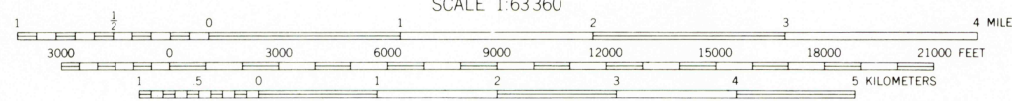


Universal Transverse Mercator projection. 1927 North American datum
