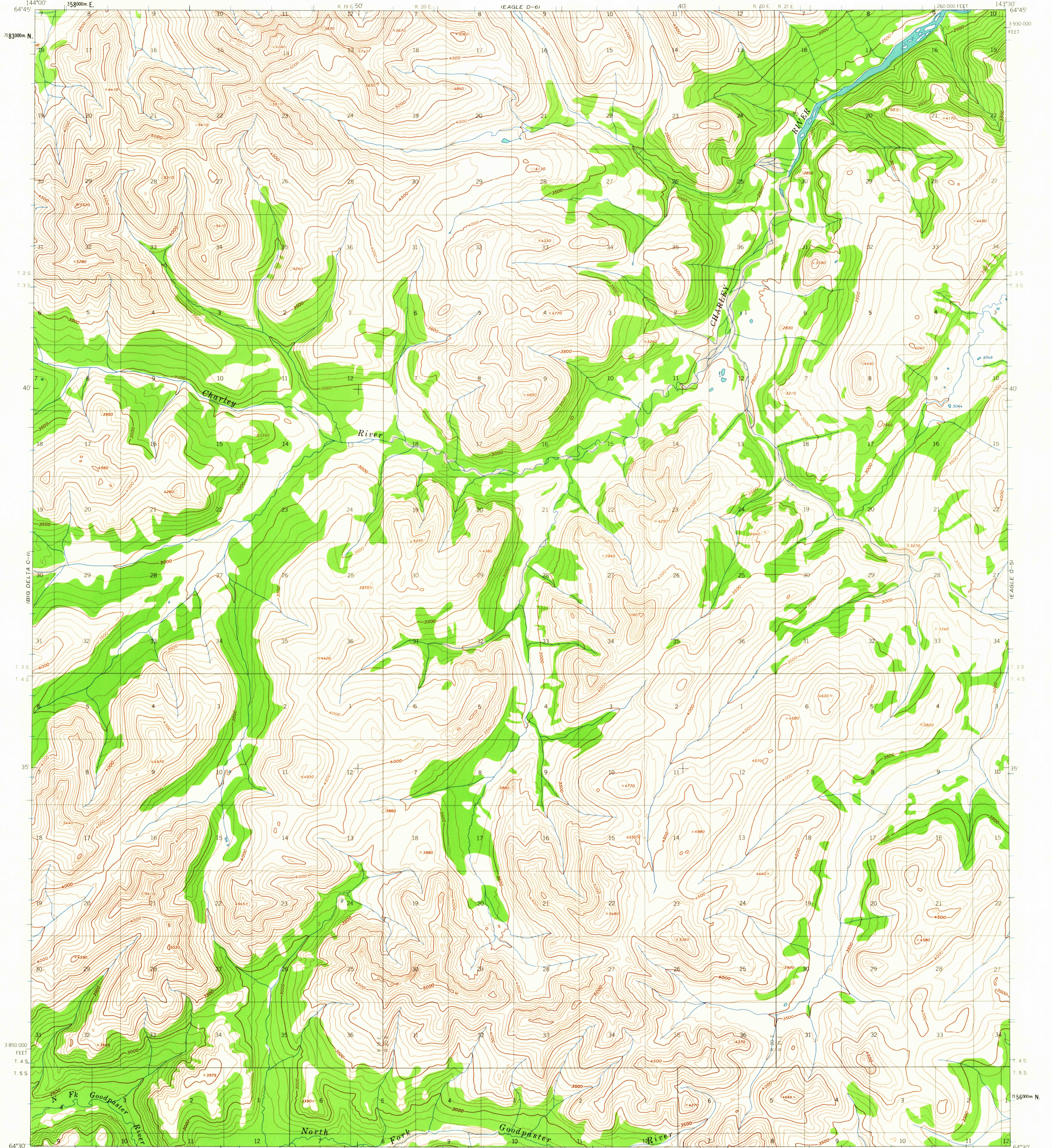

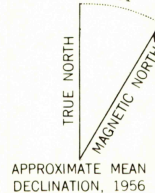
EAGLE (C-6) QUADRANGLE

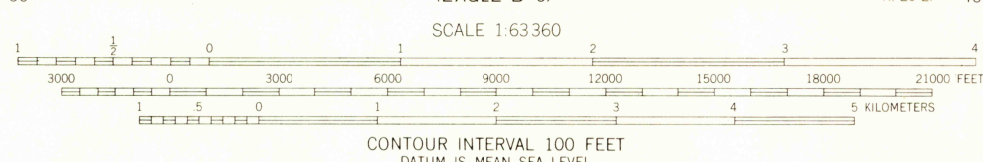
