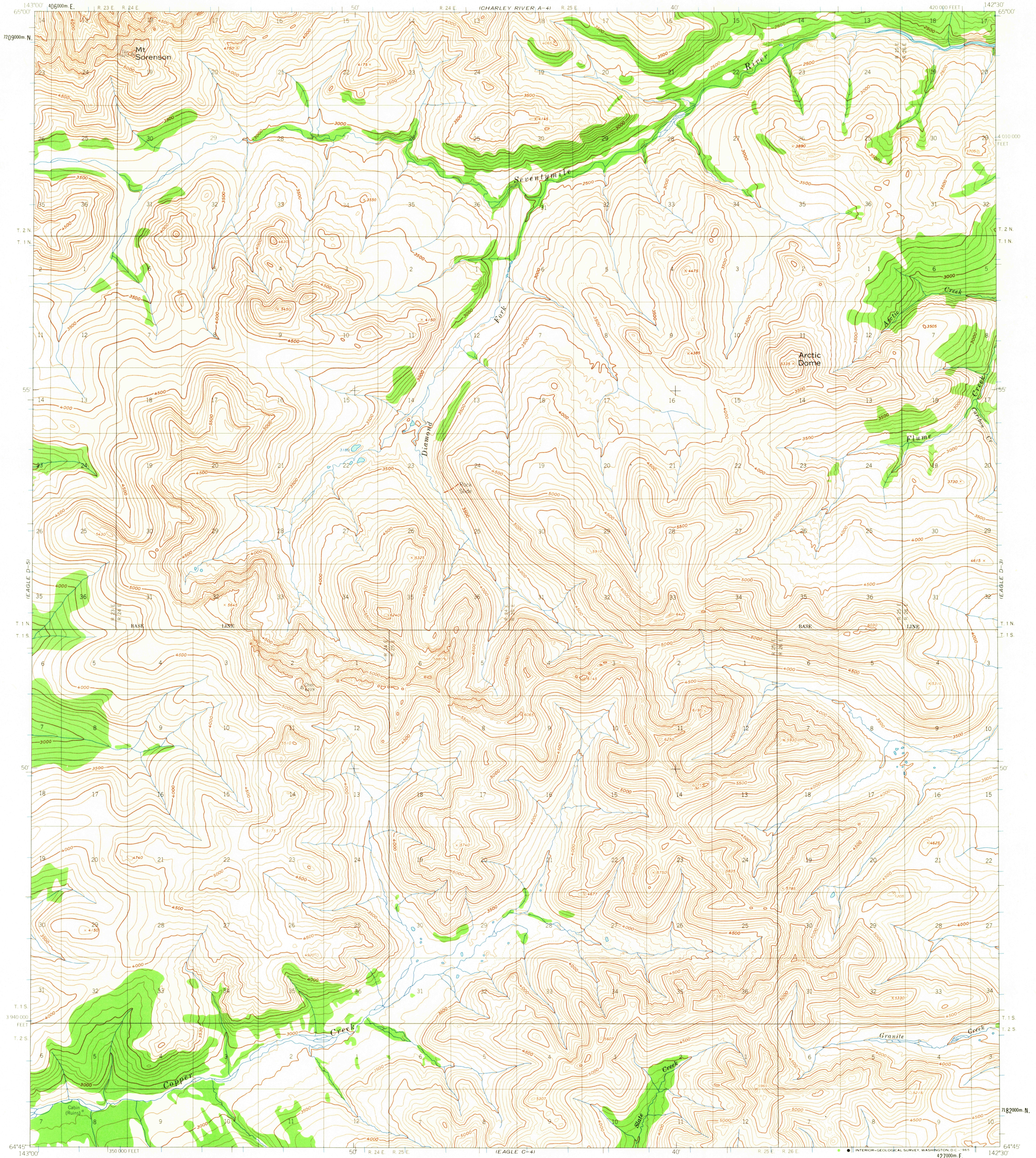
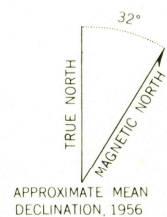

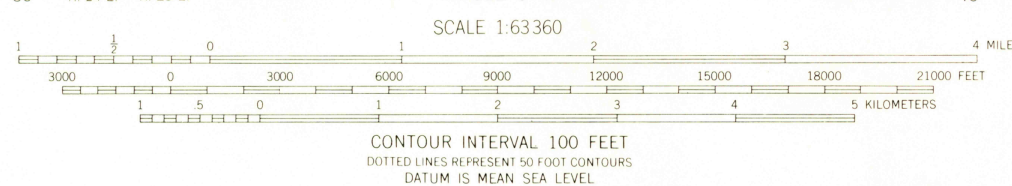
EAGLE (D-4) QUADRANGLE
