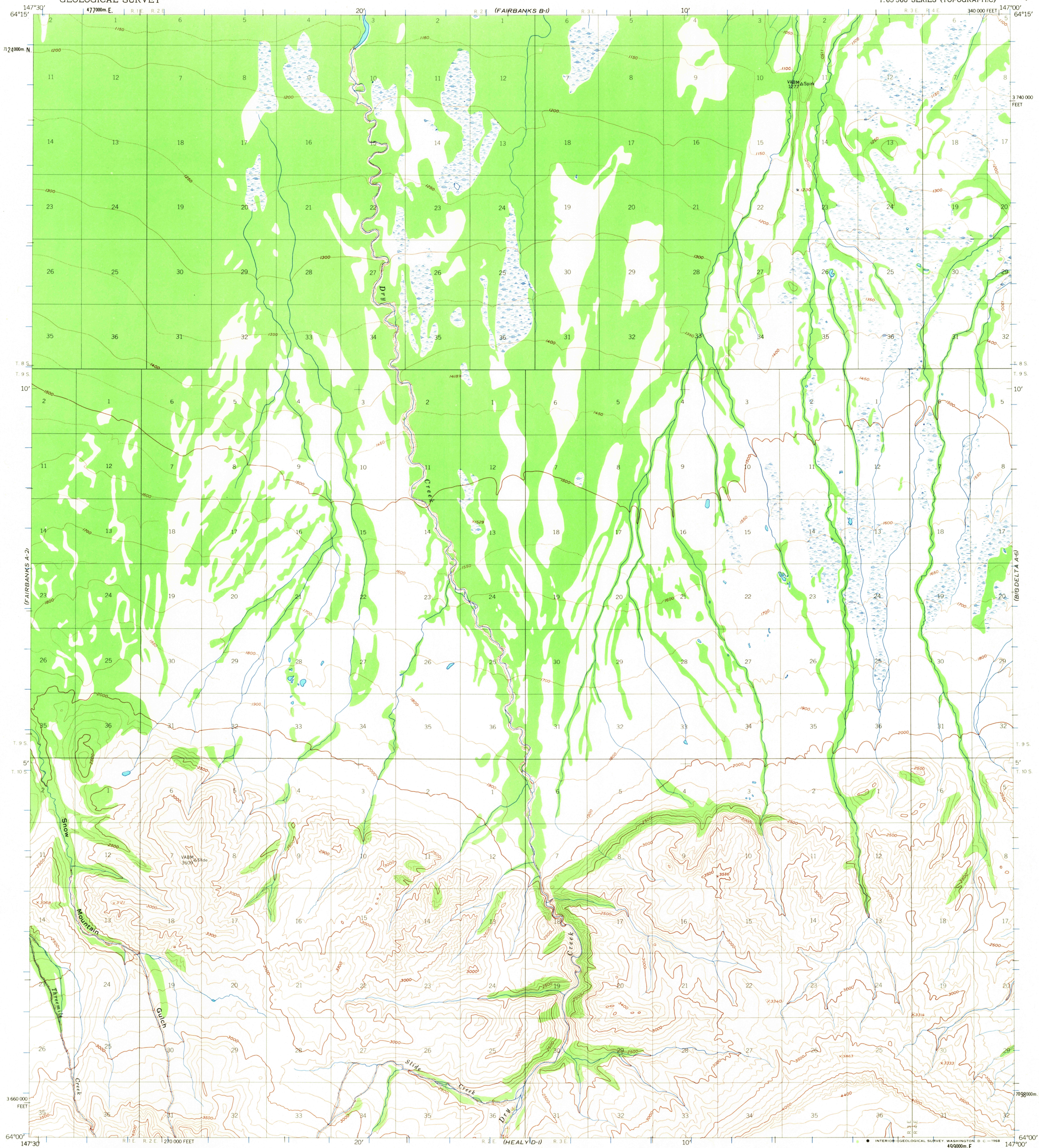

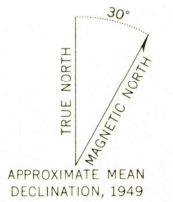
FAIRBANKS (A-1) QUADRANGLE

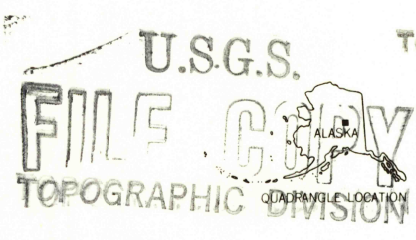
