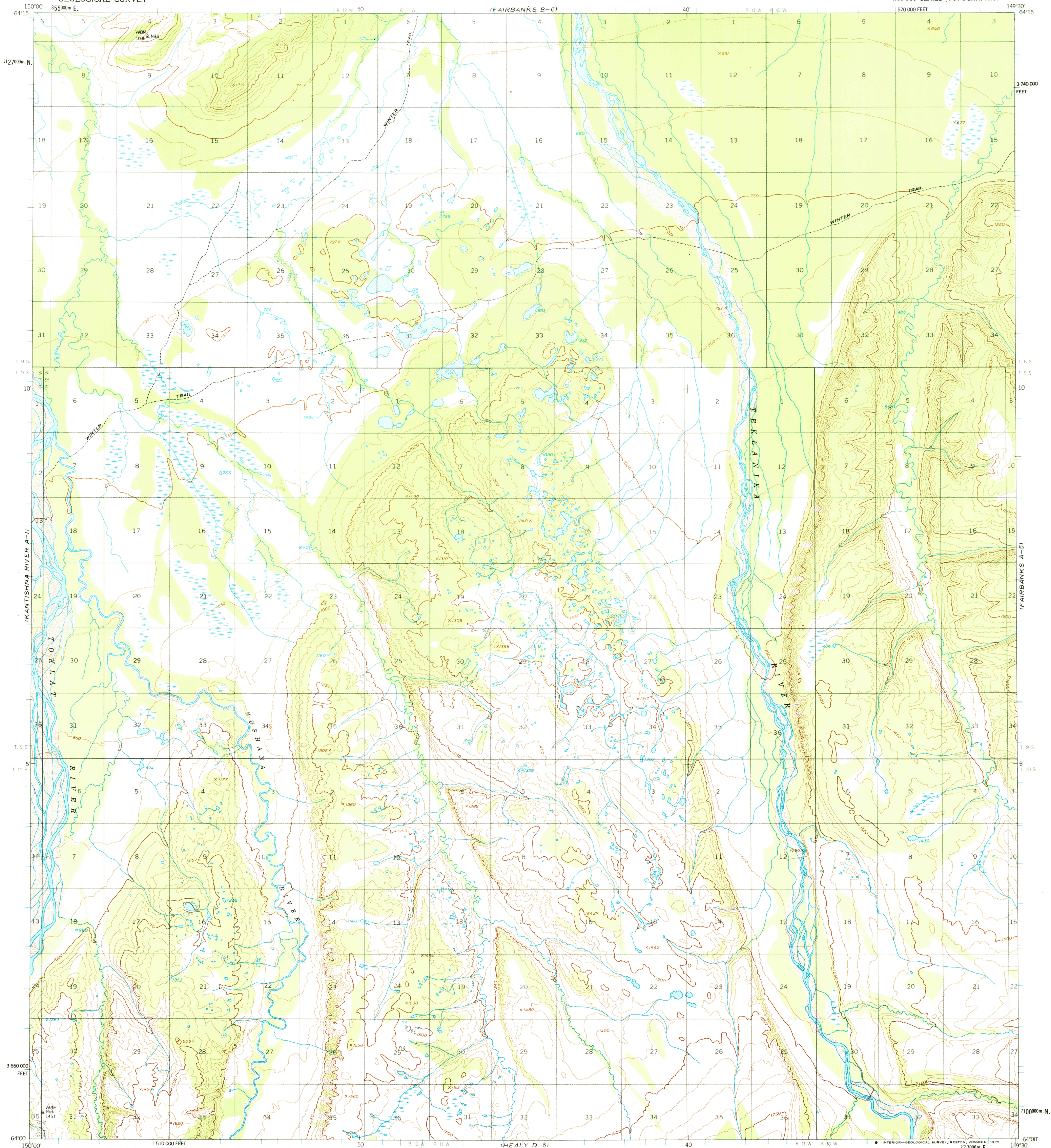

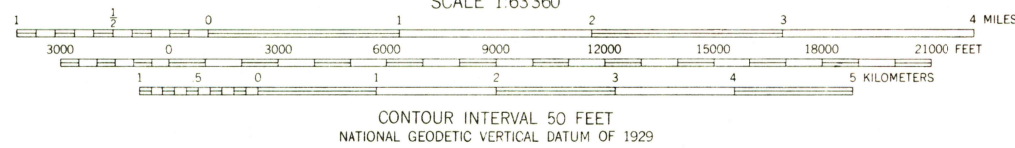
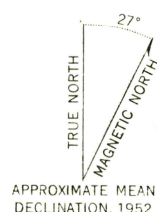
FAIRBANKS (A-6) QUADRANGLE
