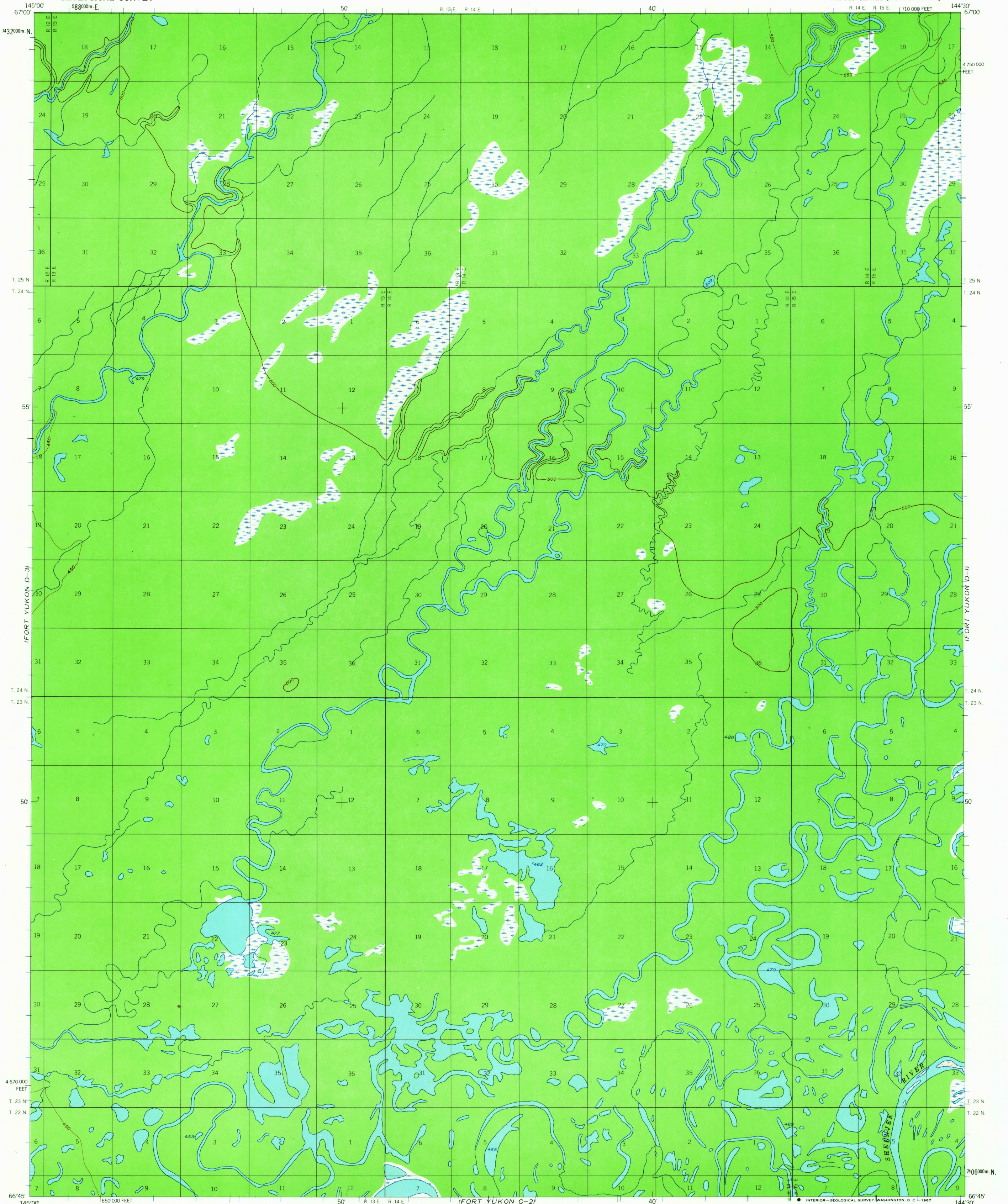

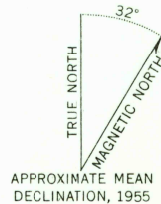

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1955. Map not field checked.

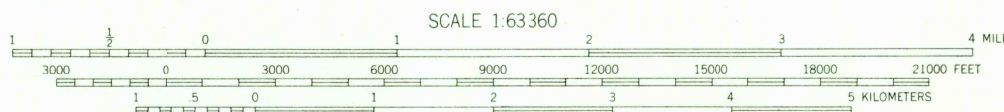
