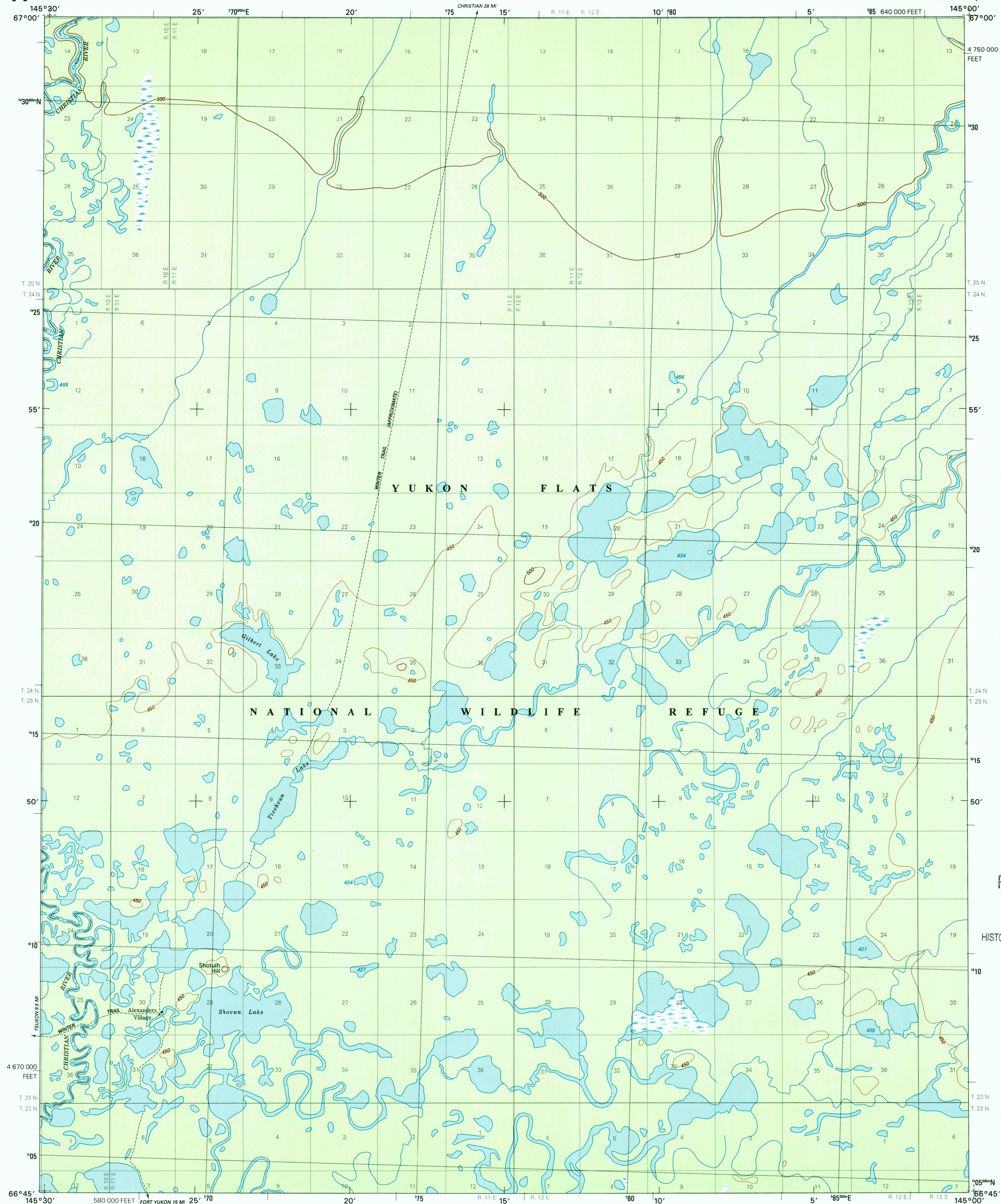

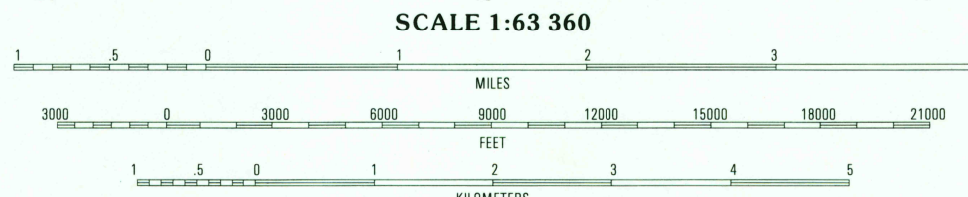
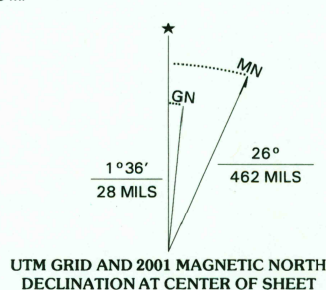
FORT YUKON D-3 QUADRANGLE
