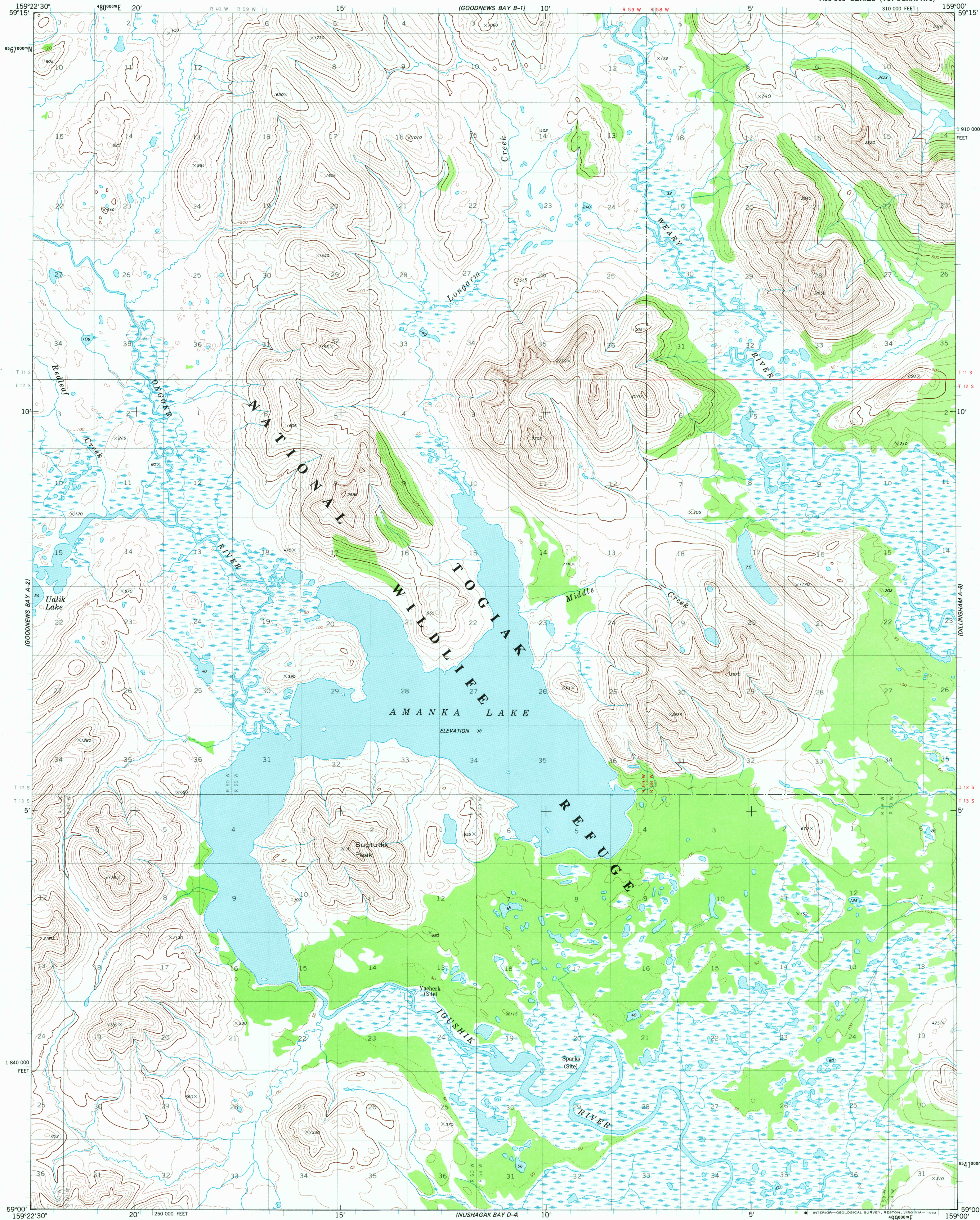

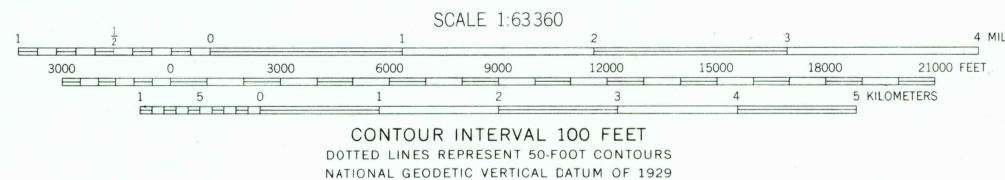
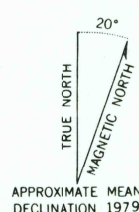
Projection and 1000-meter grid ticks: Universal
