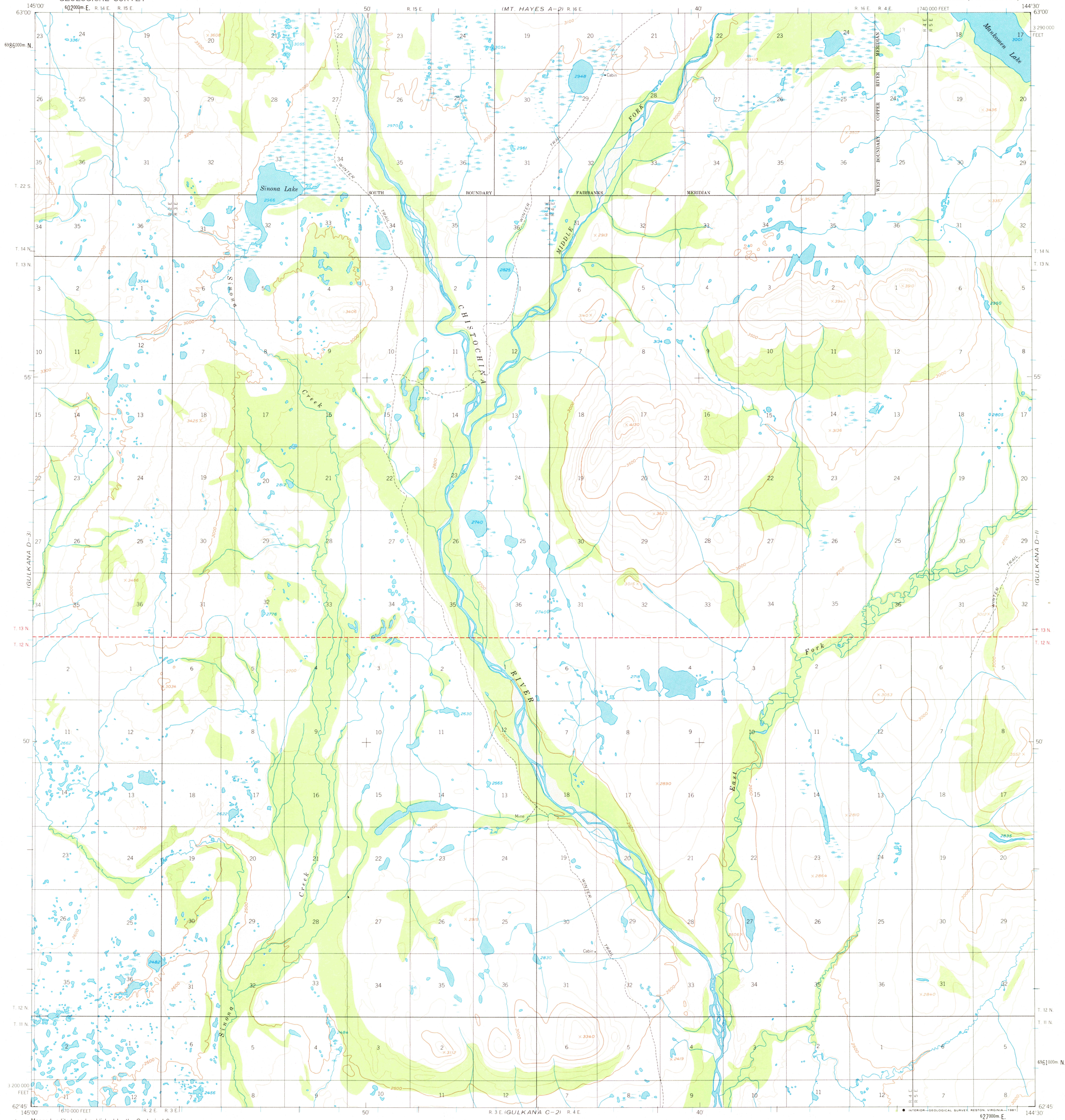
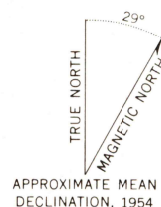

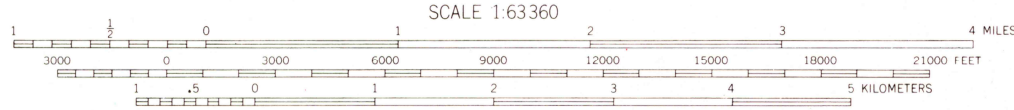
GULKANA (D-2) QUADRANGLE

Folios CR 3, Copper River Meridian and F.9, Fairbanks Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 51 meters north and 113 meters east
