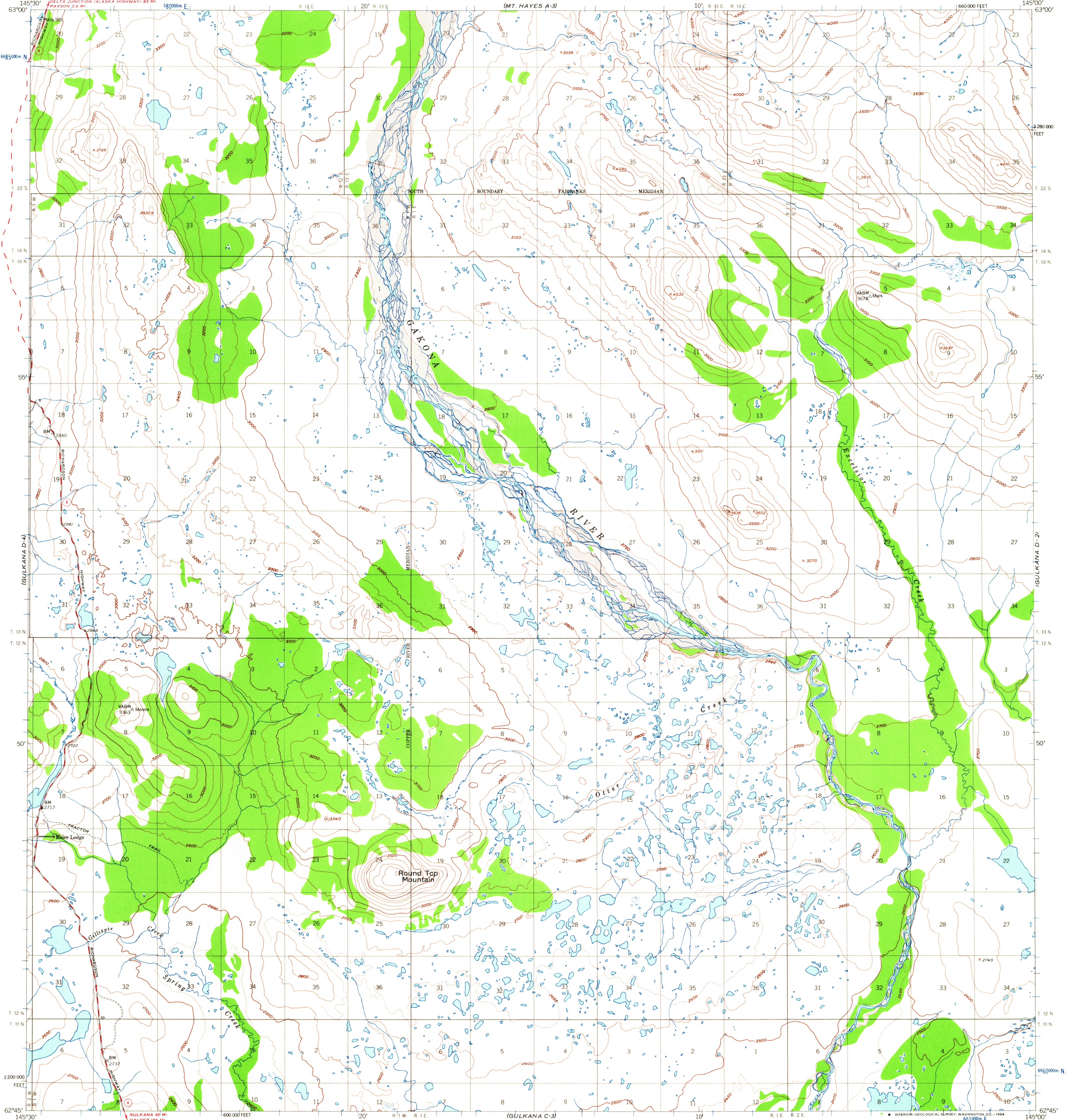

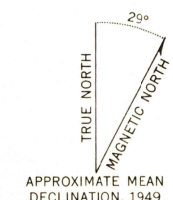
GULKANA (D-3) QUADRANGLE
