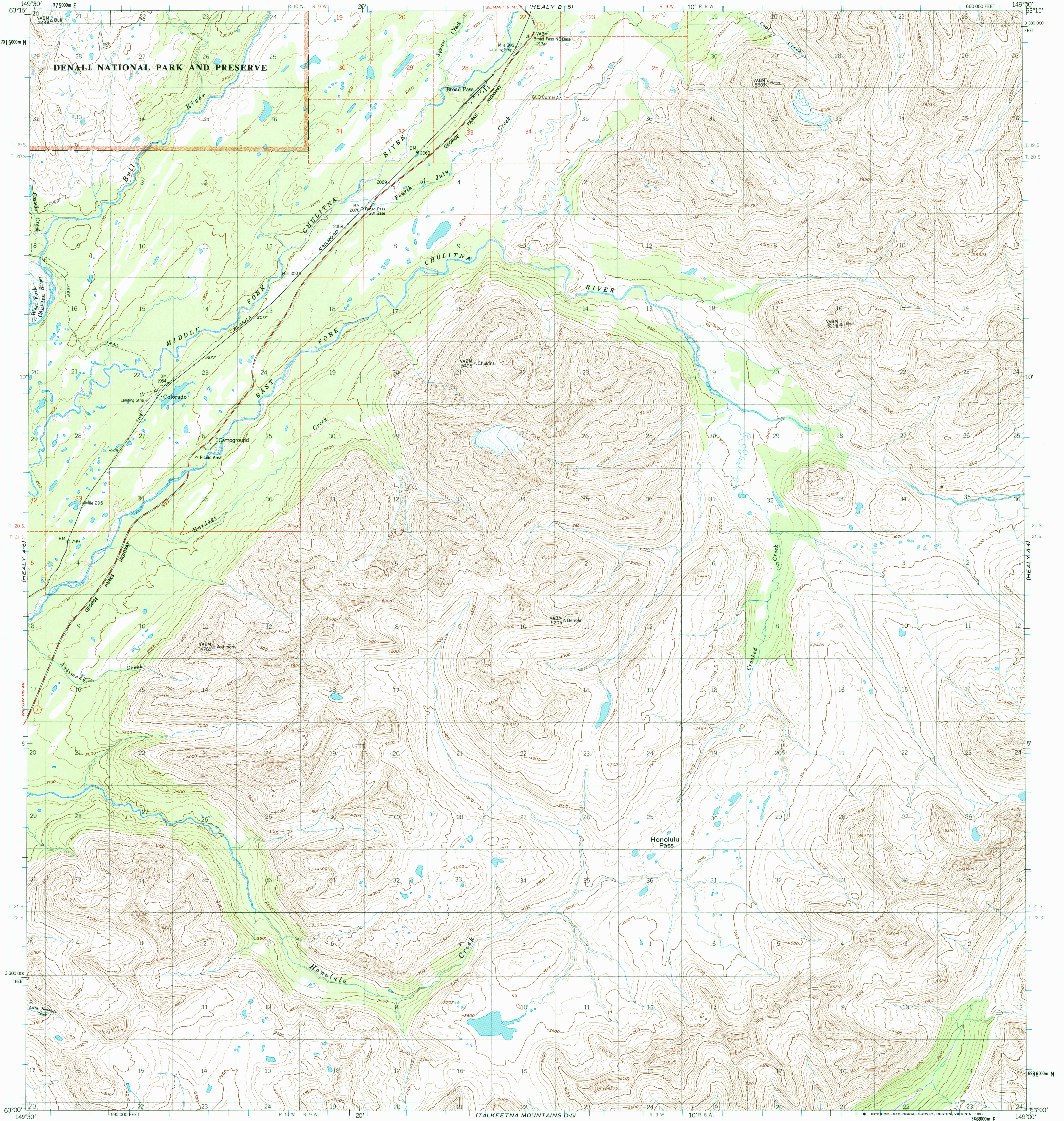
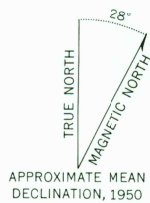

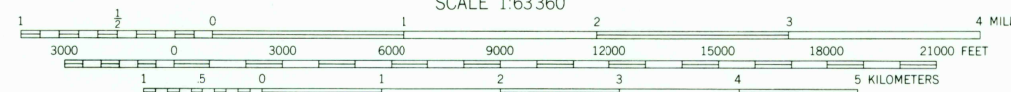

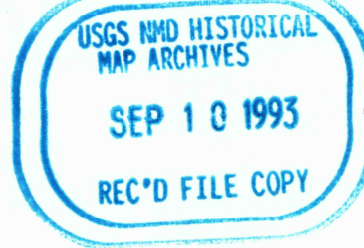


APPROXIMATE MEAN
