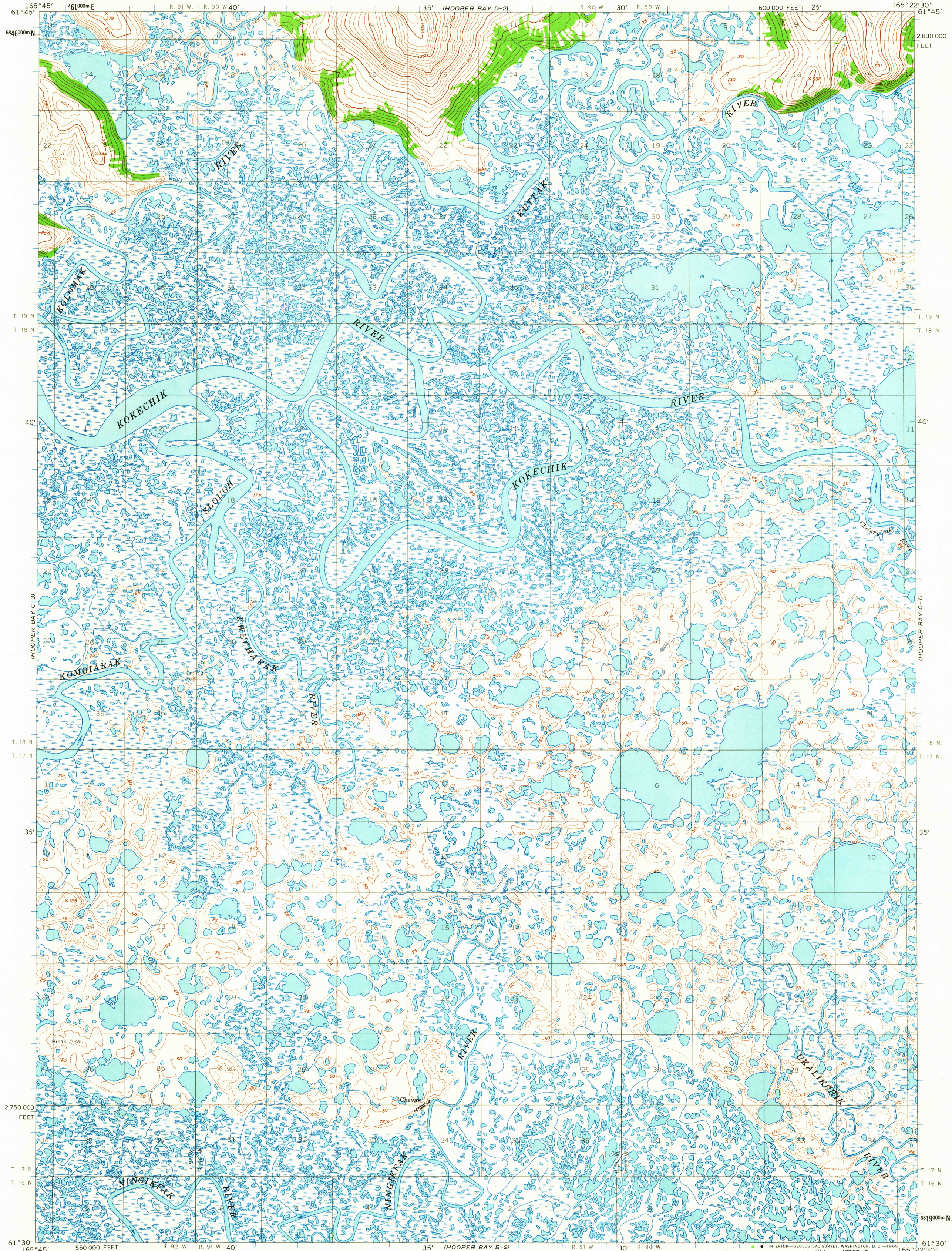

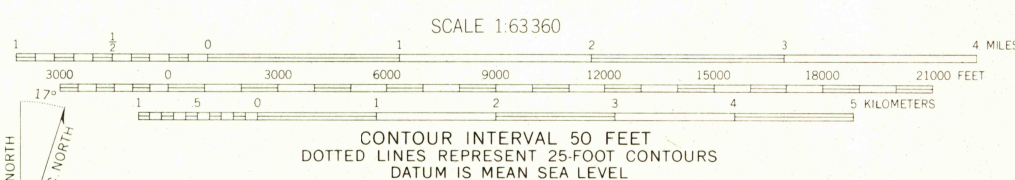
HOOPER BAY (C-2) QUADRANGLE
