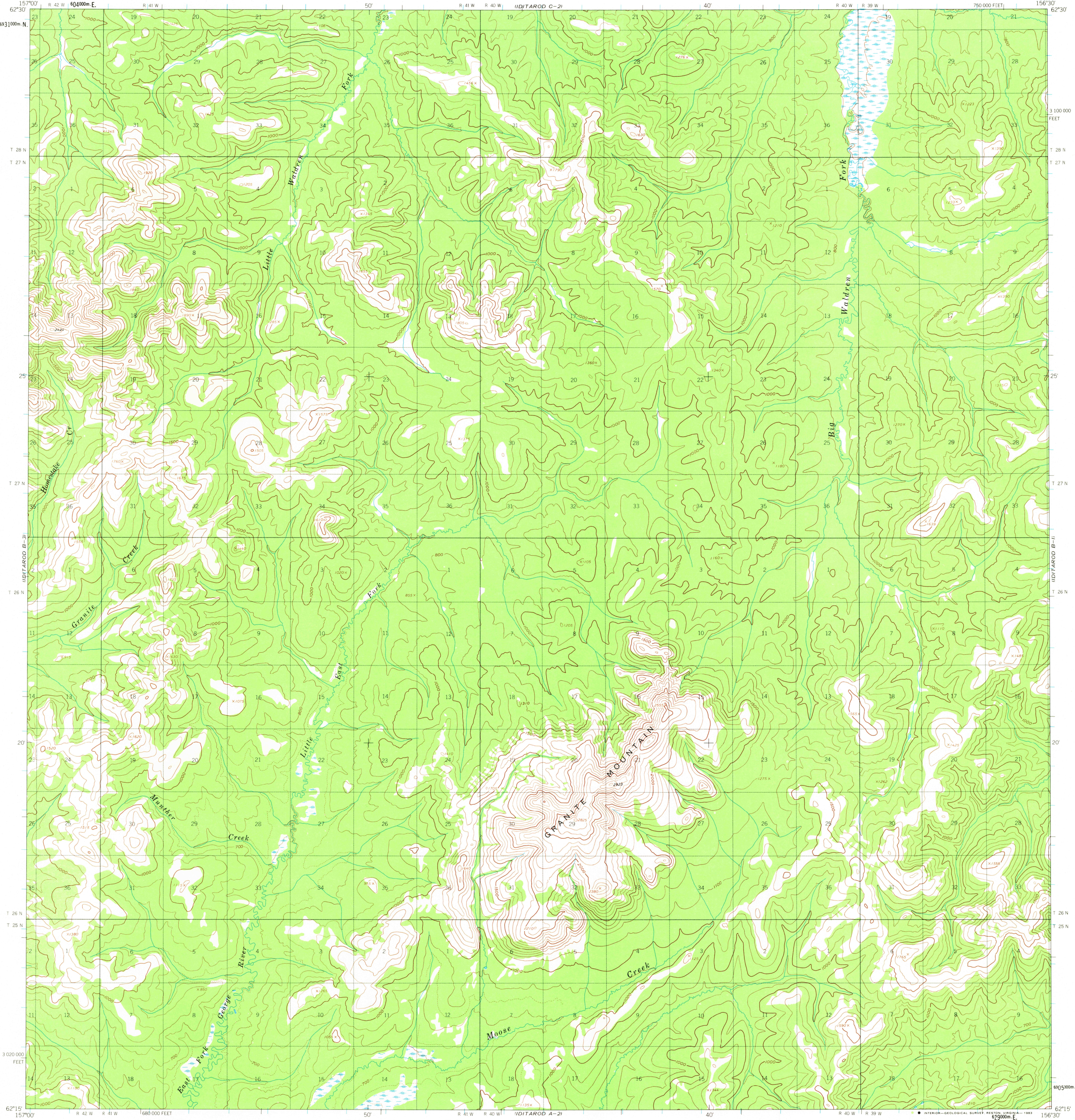
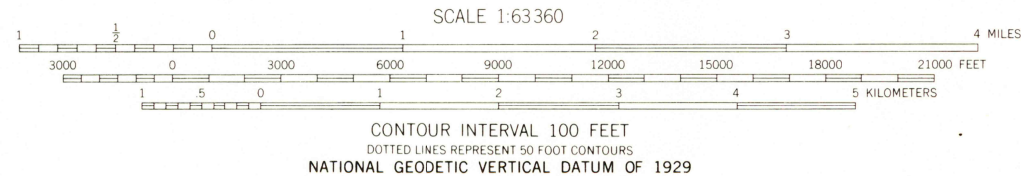
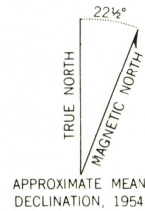

Folio S-4, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 76 meters north and 126 meters east
