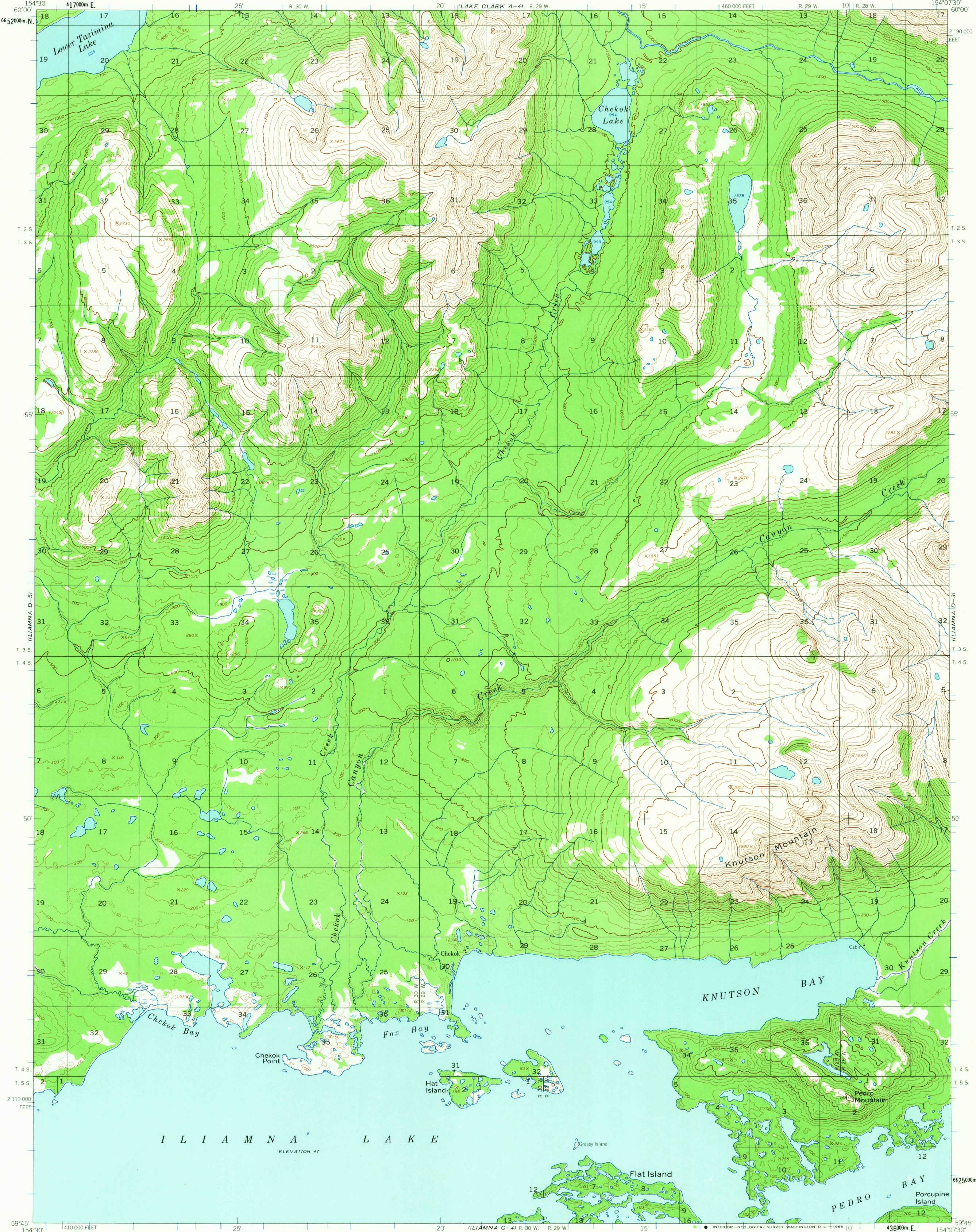

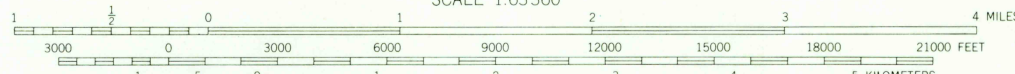
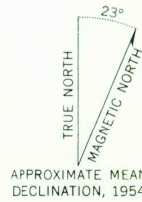
ILIAMNA (D-4) QUADRANGLE
