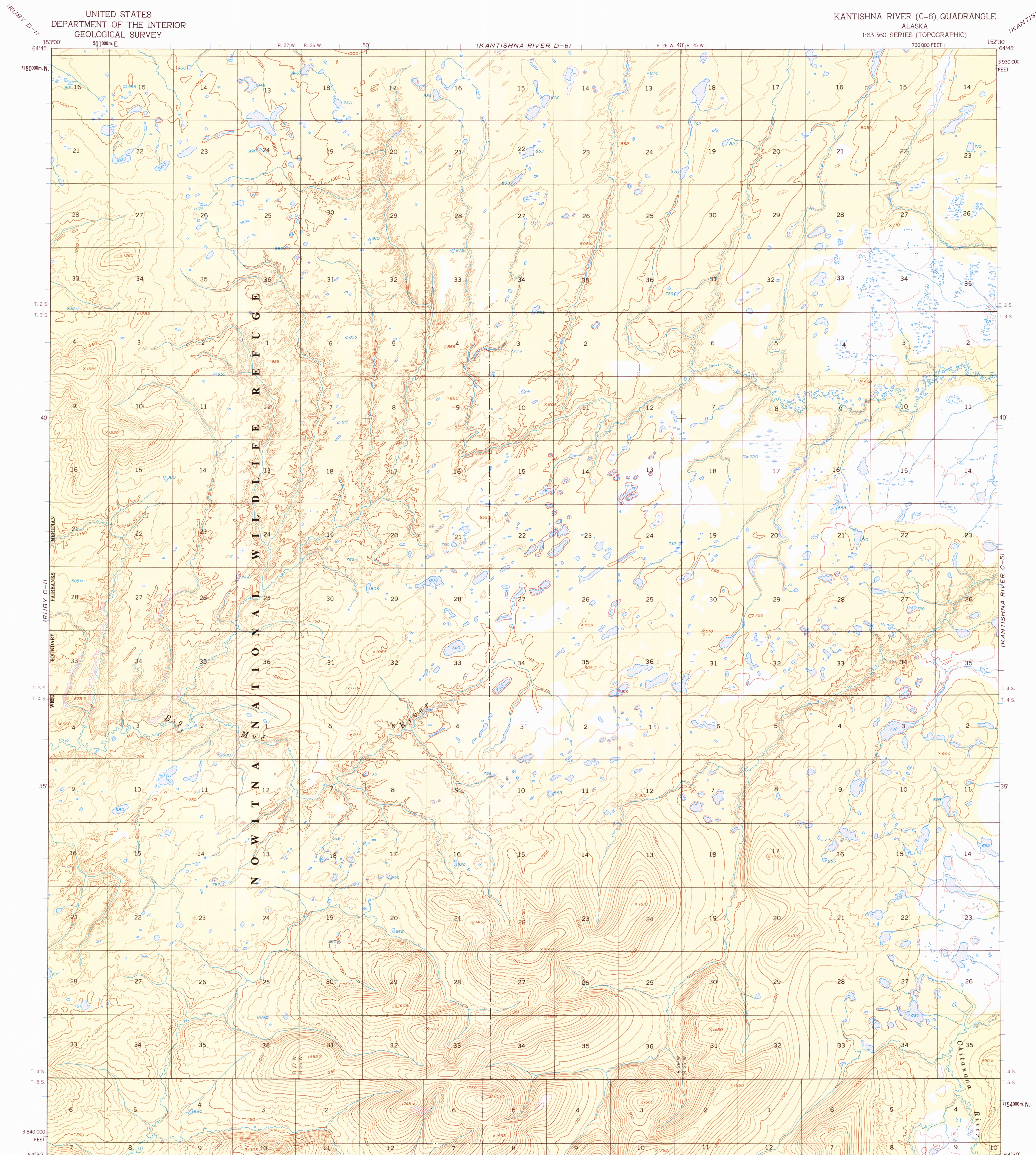

Projection and 1000-meter grid ticks shown in blue:
Universal Transverse Mercator, zone 5
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 5, 1927 North American datum
To place on the projected North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 62 meters north and 121 meters east
Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management
Folio F-11, Fairbanks Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
