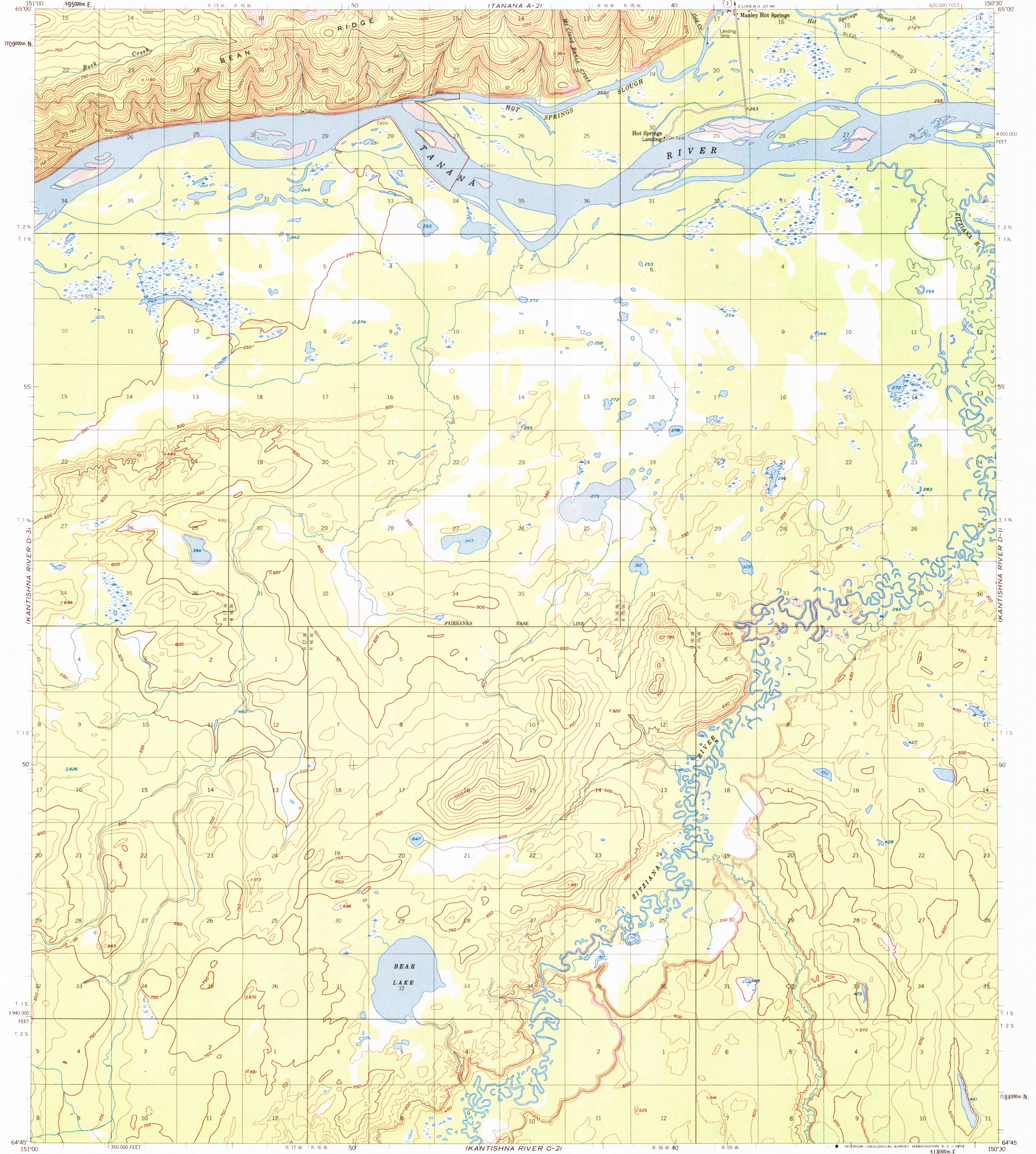
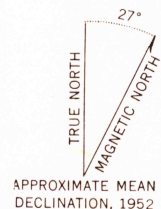

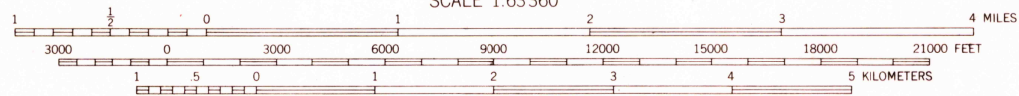
KANTISHNA RIVER (D-2) QUADRANGLE
