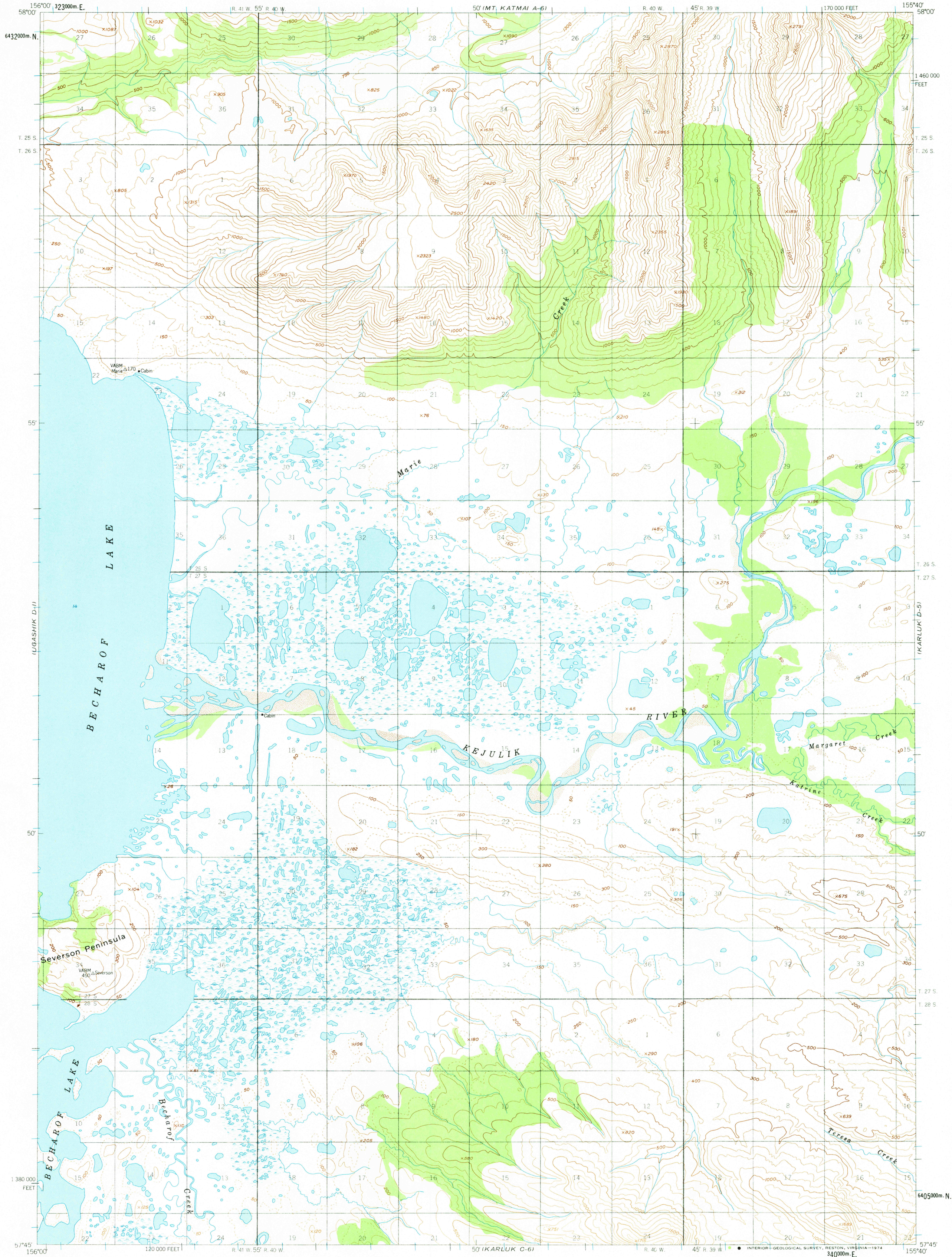

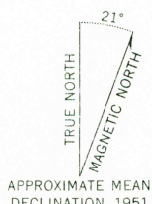
KARLUK (D-6) QUADRANGLE

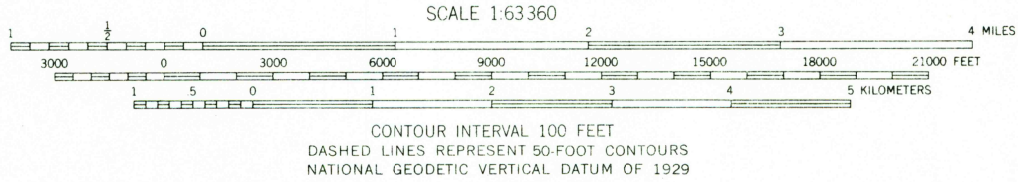
