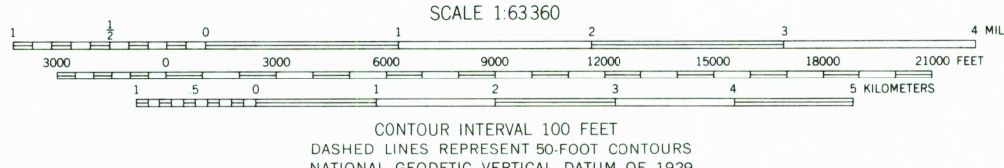
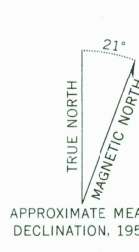

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management
Folio S-22, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 81 meters north and 135 meters east
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the Becharof National Monument shown on this map
