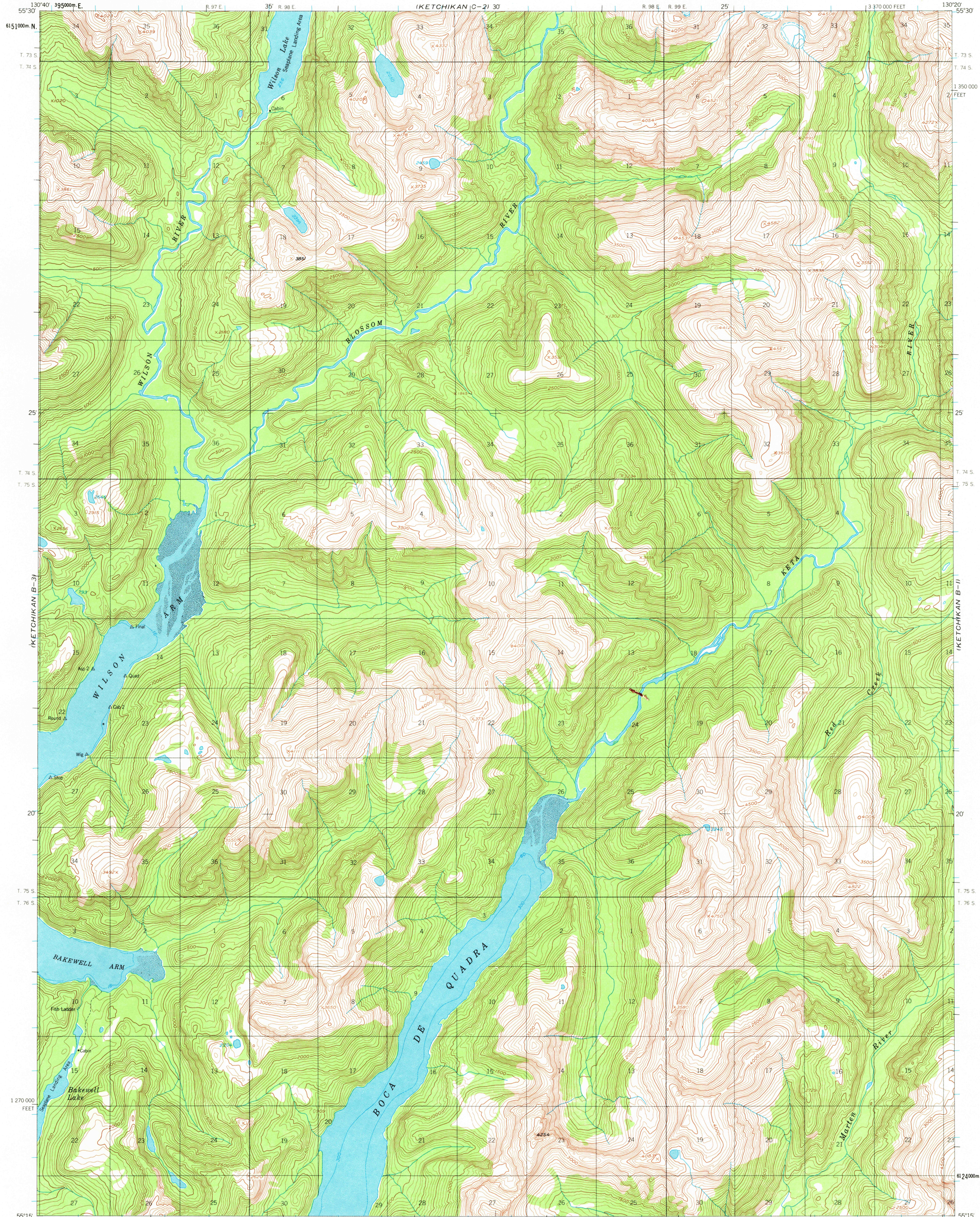

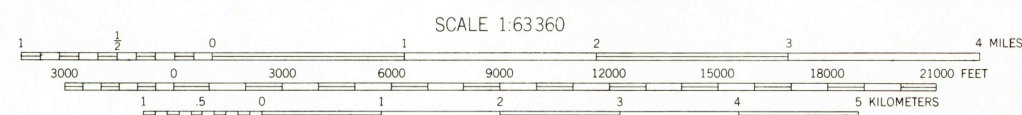
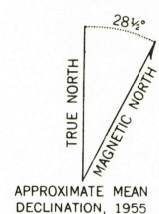

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the State of Alaska, Division of Lands Copper River Meridian

Entire land area is within the Tongass National Forest and Misty Fjords National Monument

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 35 meters north and 107 meters east
