

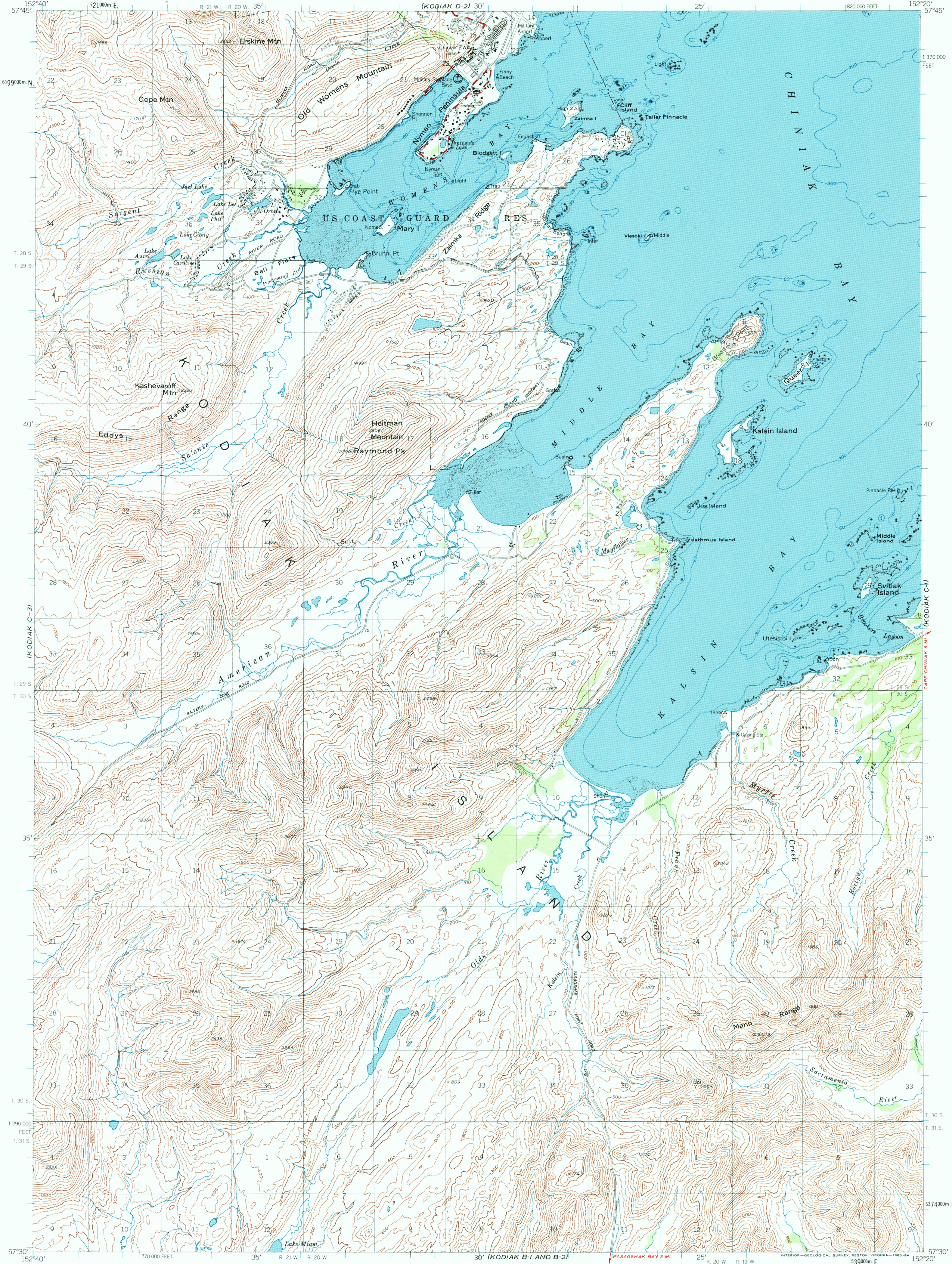

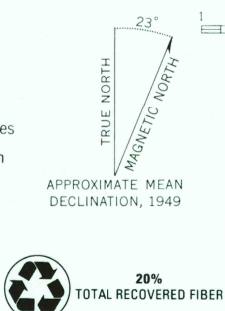
KODIAK (C-2) QUADRANGLE
