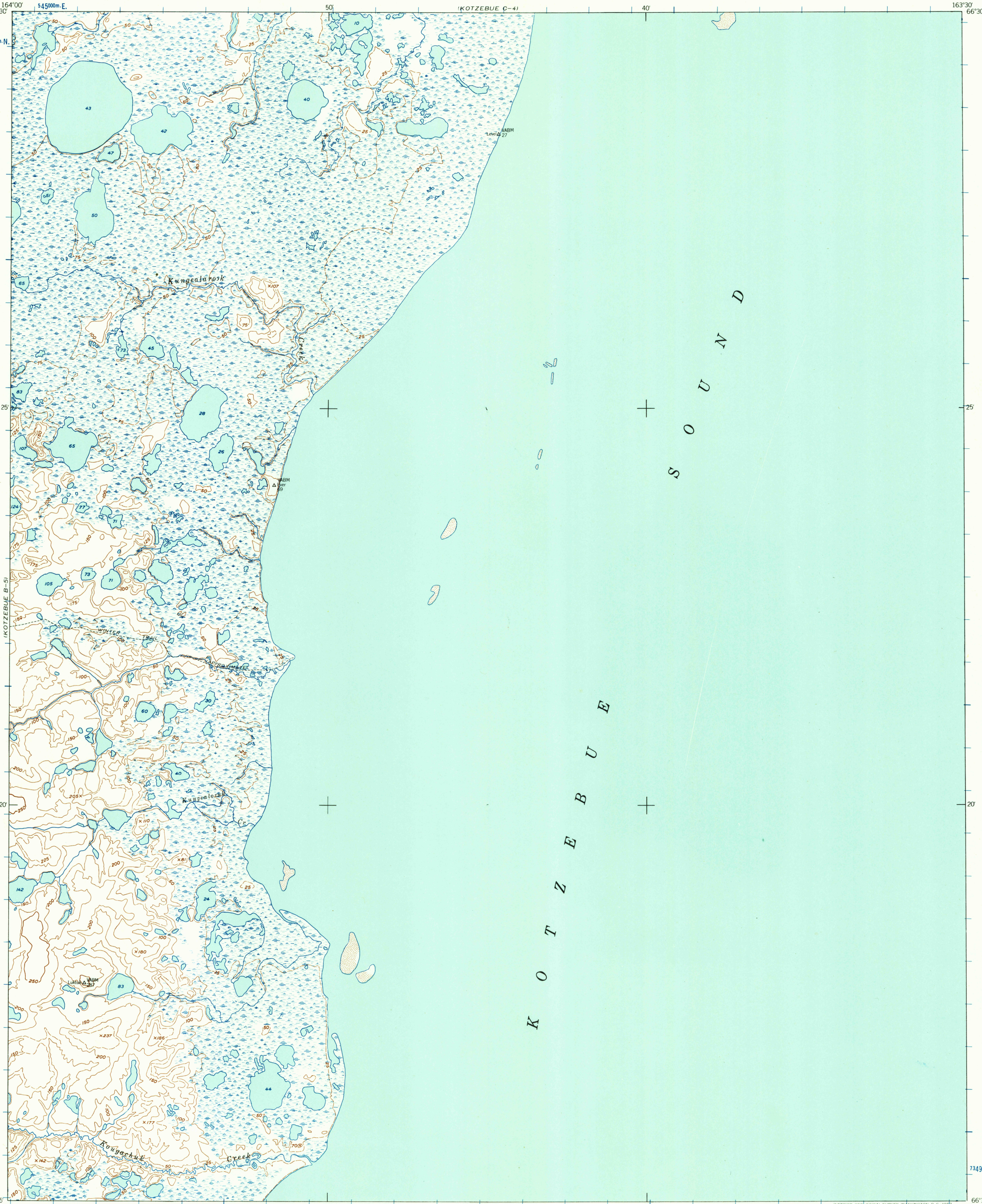

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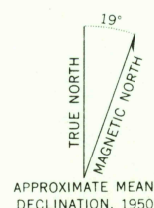

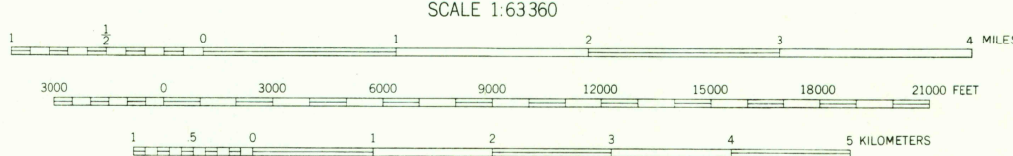

CONTOUR INTERVAL 50 FEET

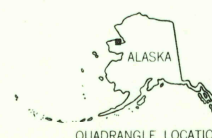
DASHED LINES REPRESENT 25 FOOT CONTOURS
