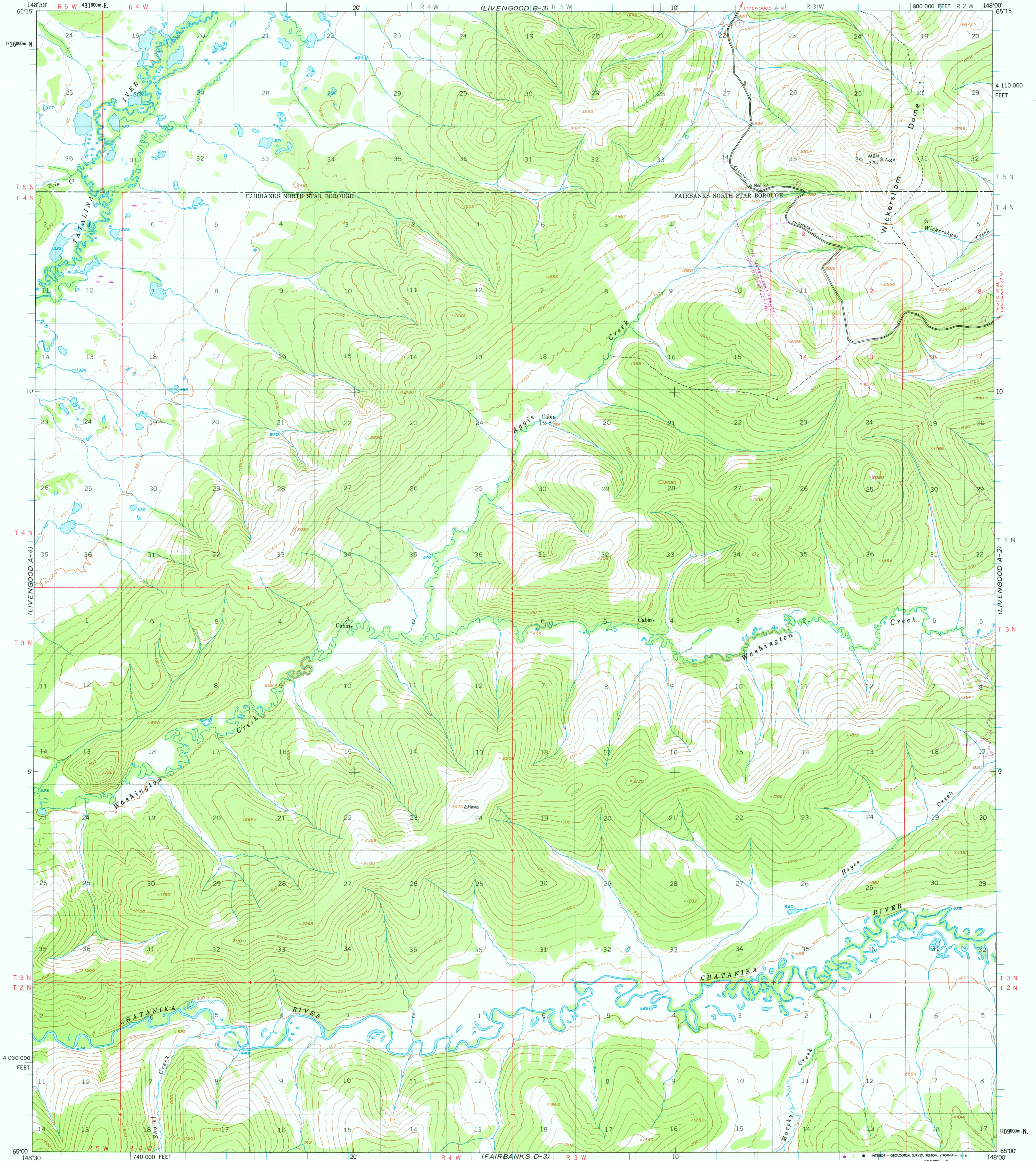

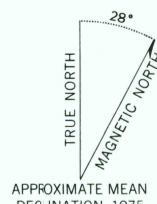

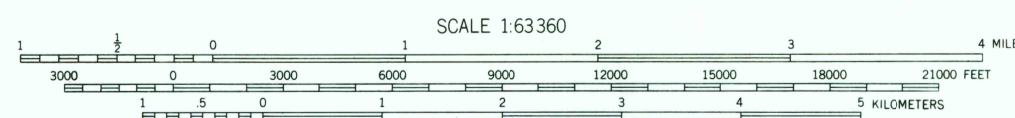
Projection and 1000-meter grid ticks: Universal Transverse Mercator, zone 6
