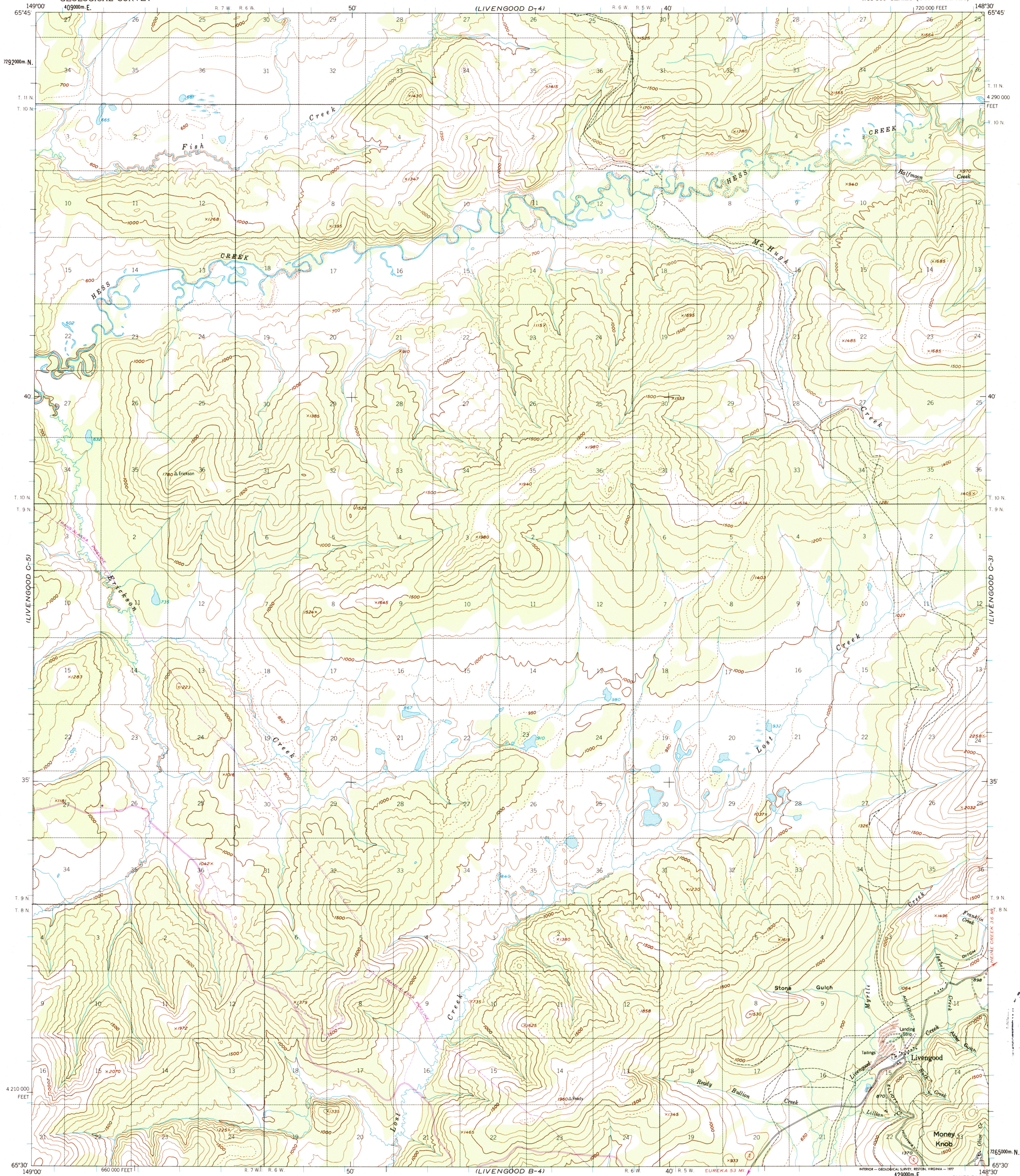

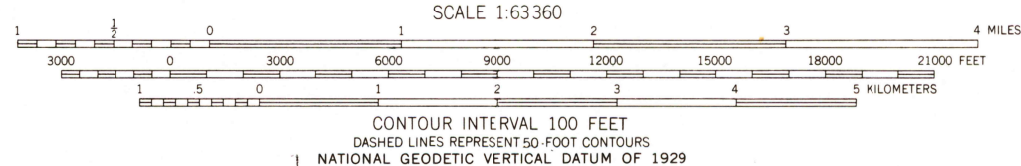
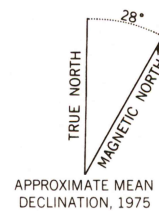
LIVNGOOD (C-4) QUADRANGLE
