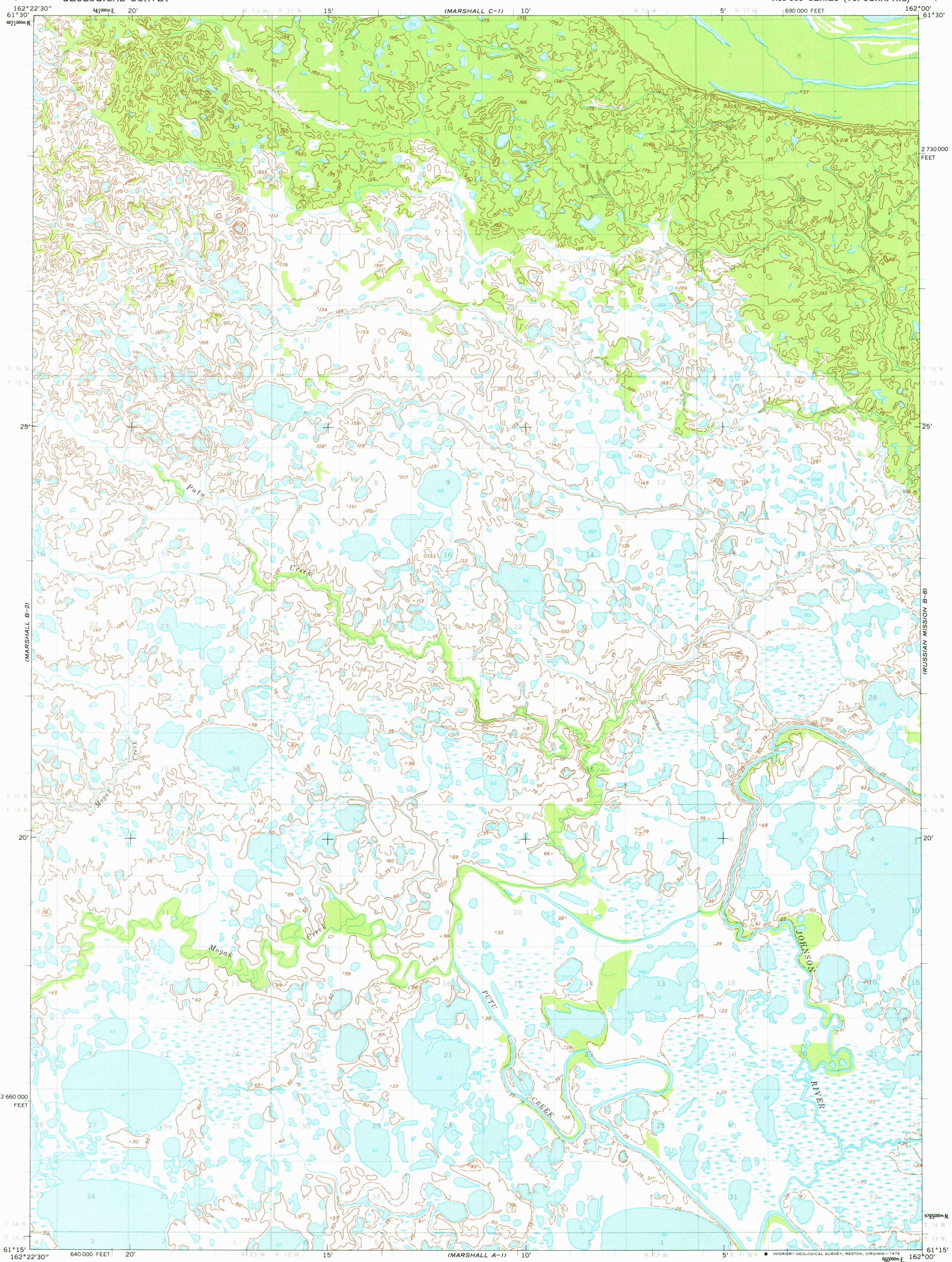

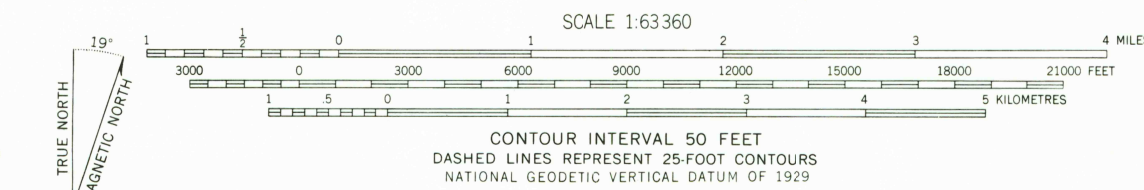
MARSHALL (B-1) QUADRANGLE
