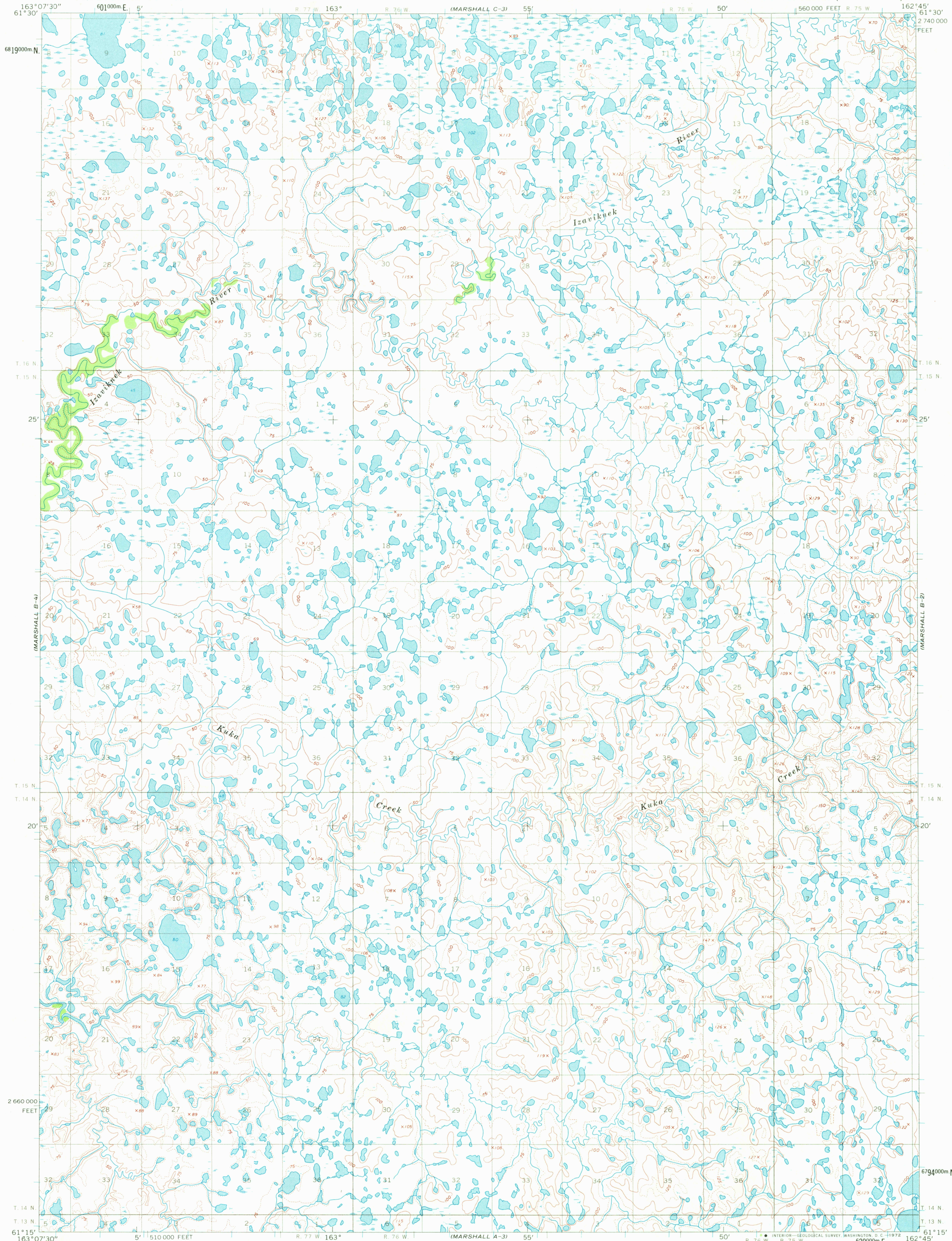

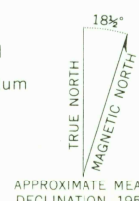
MARSHALL (B-3) QUADRANGLE

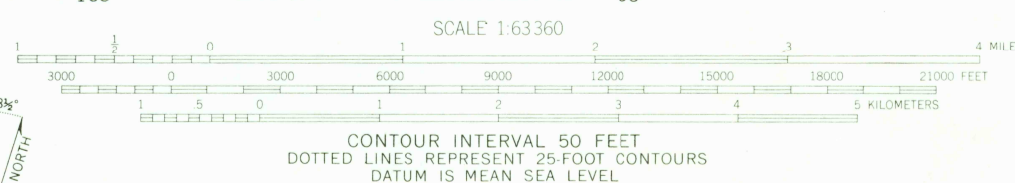
