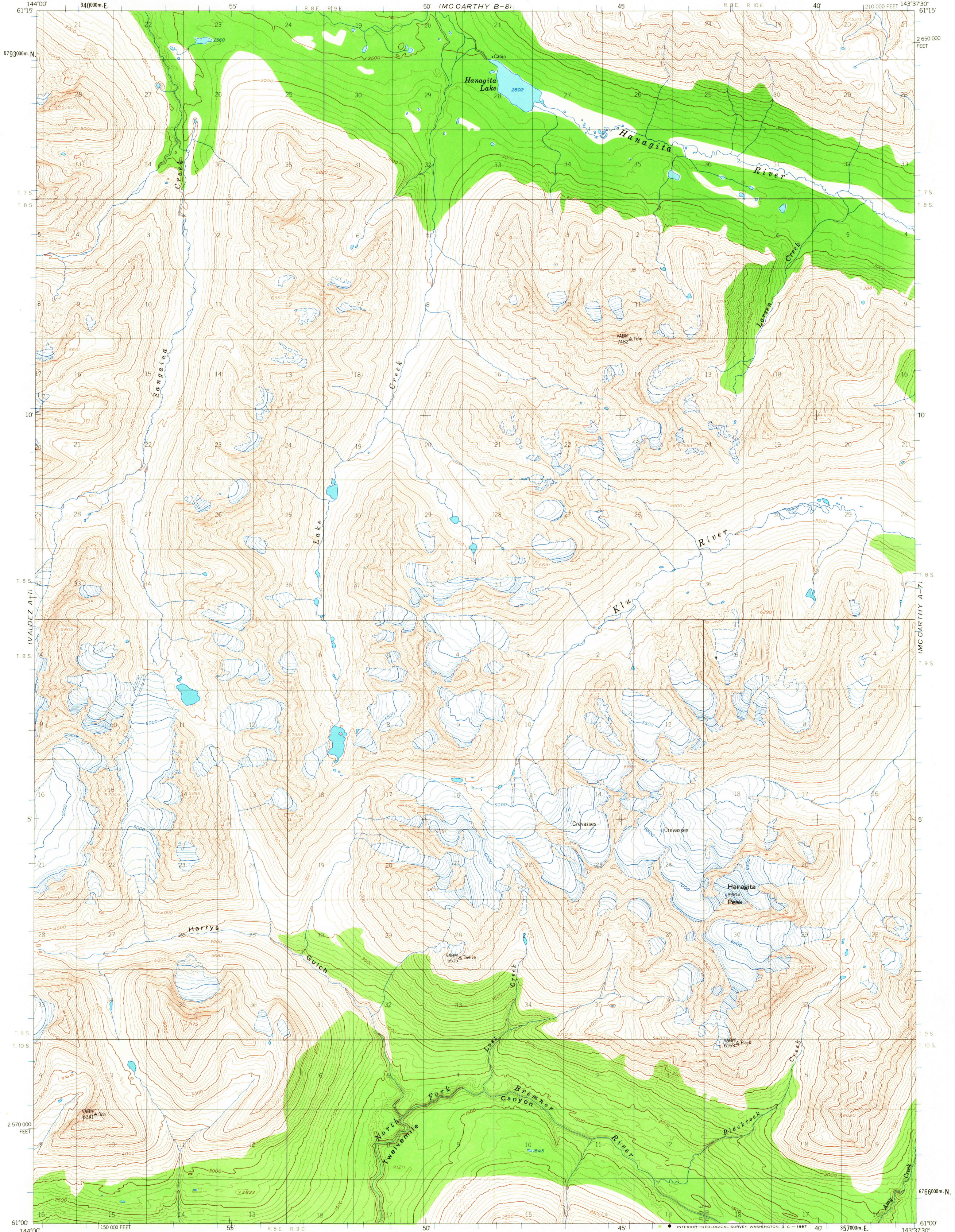




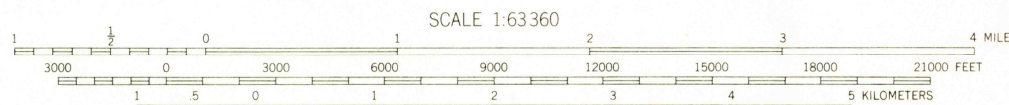
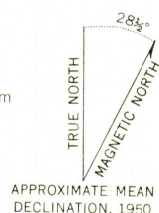

Folio CR-6, Copper River Meridian

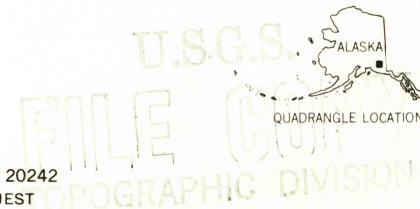
