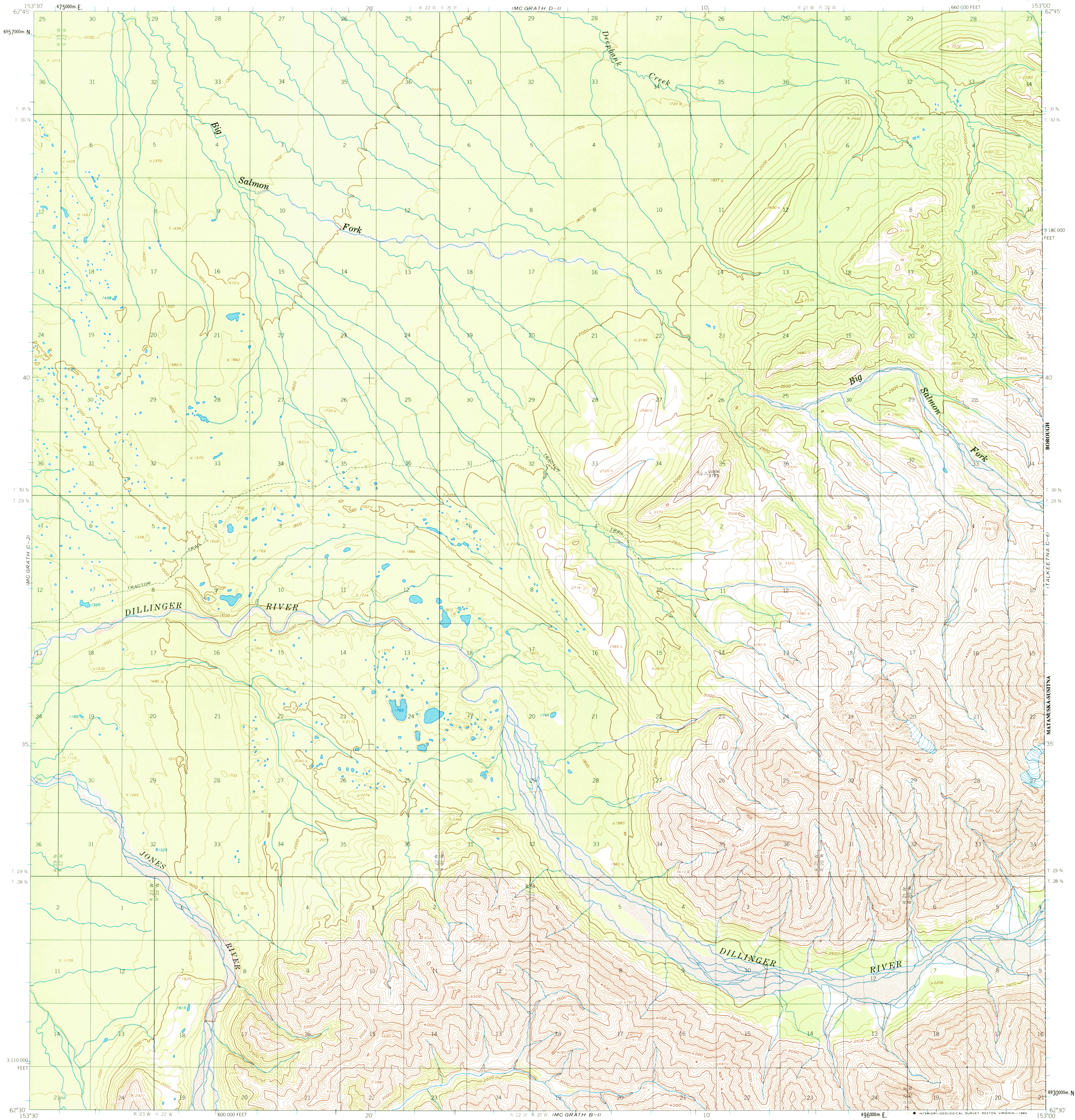

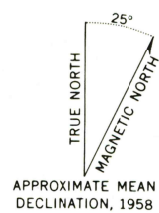

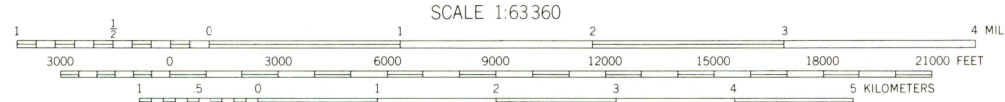

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-3, Seward Meridian

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 68 meters north and 123 meters east
