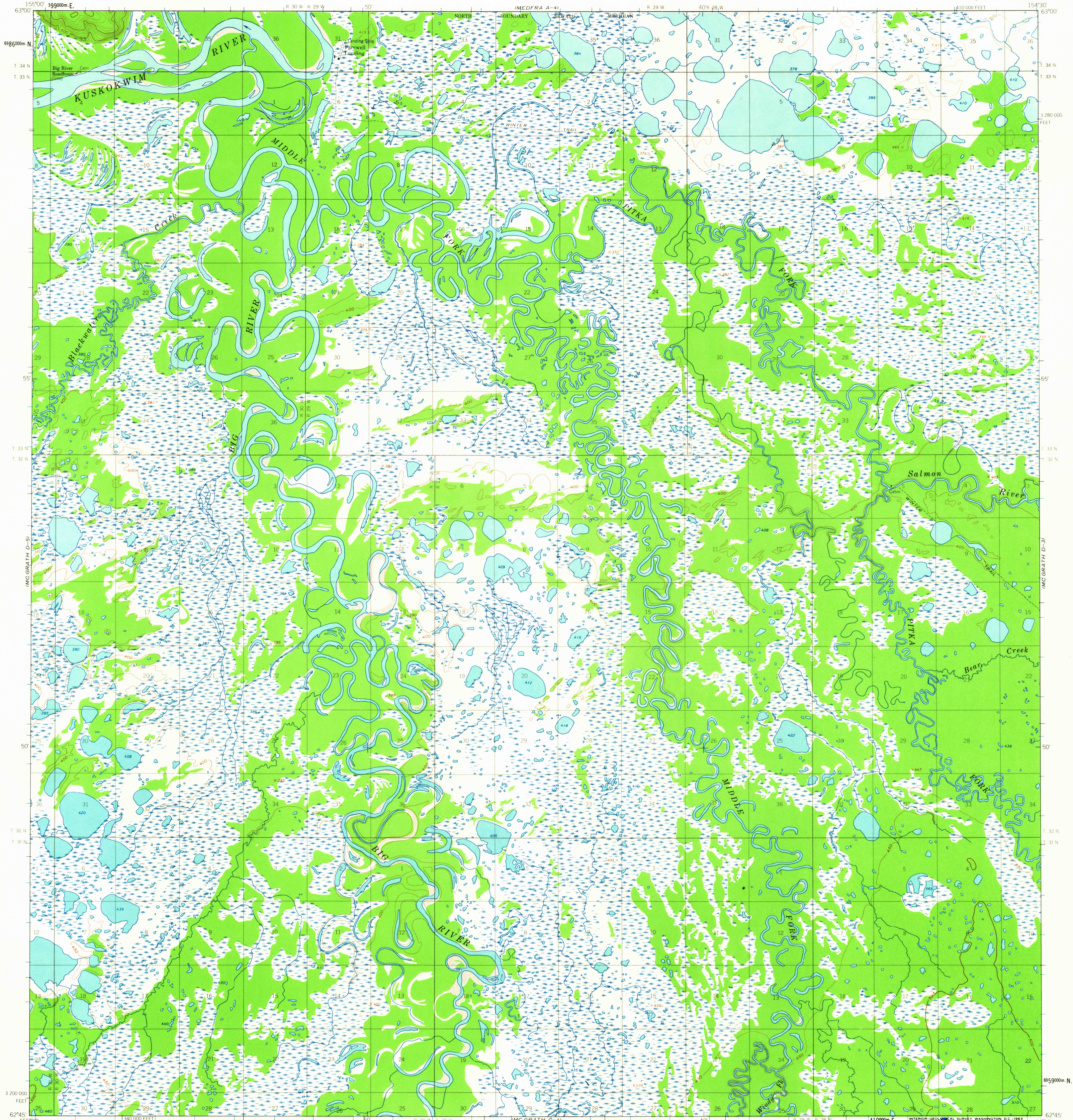

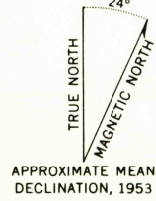
MC GRATH (D-4) QUADRANGLE

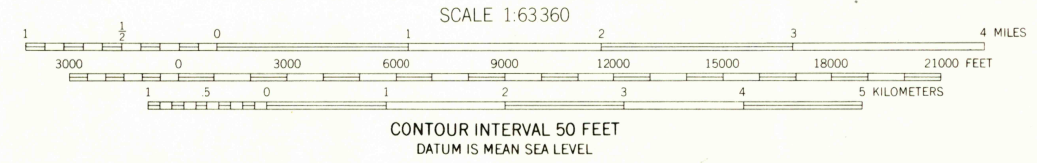
