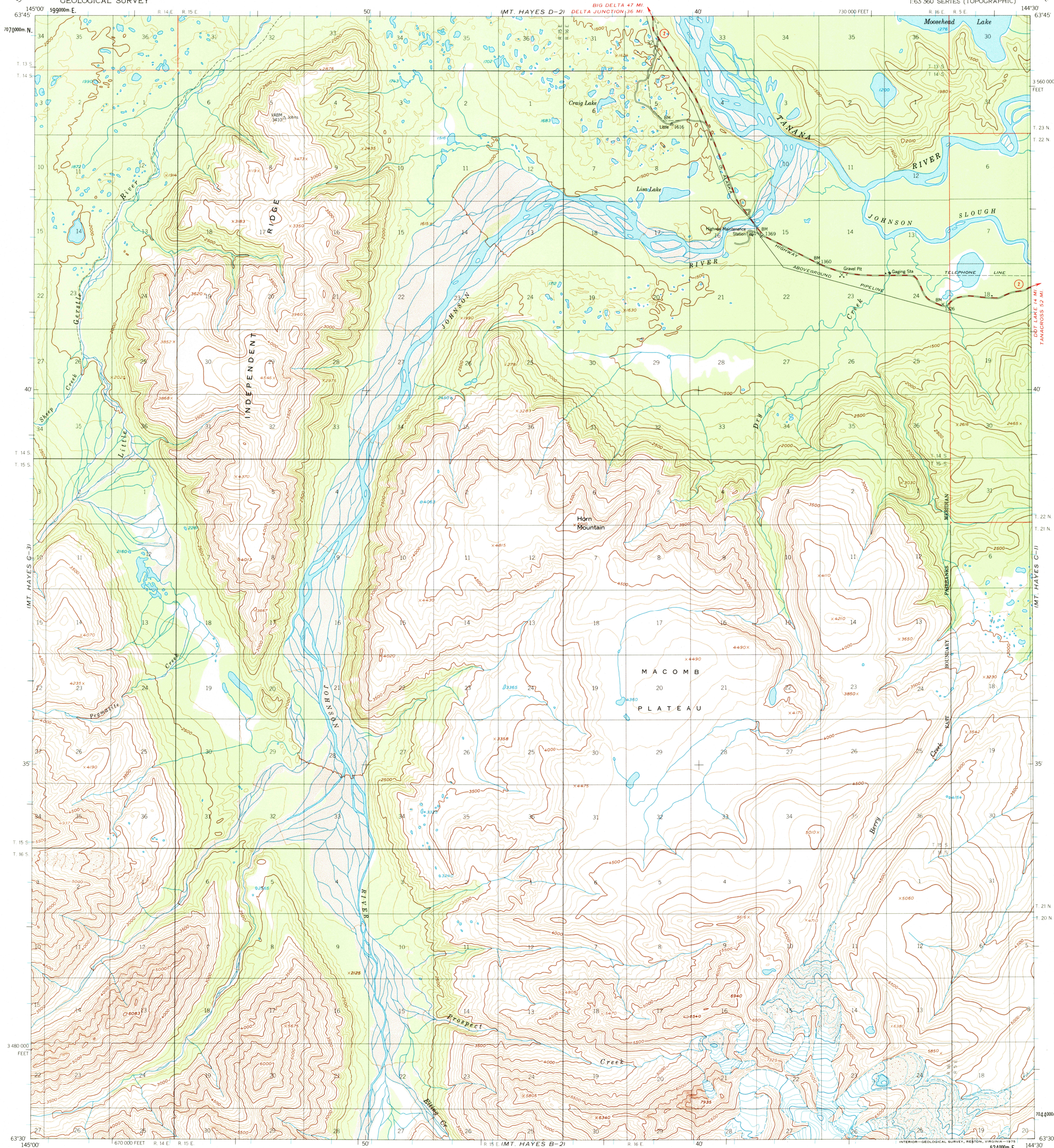




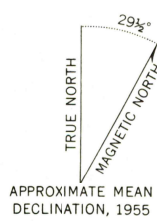

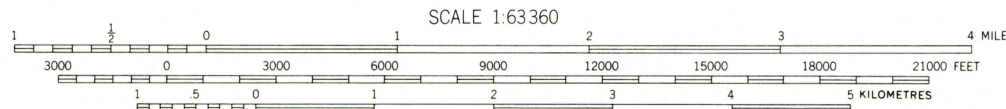

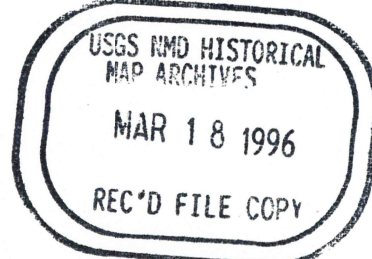


APPROXIMATE MEAN DECLINATION, 1955
