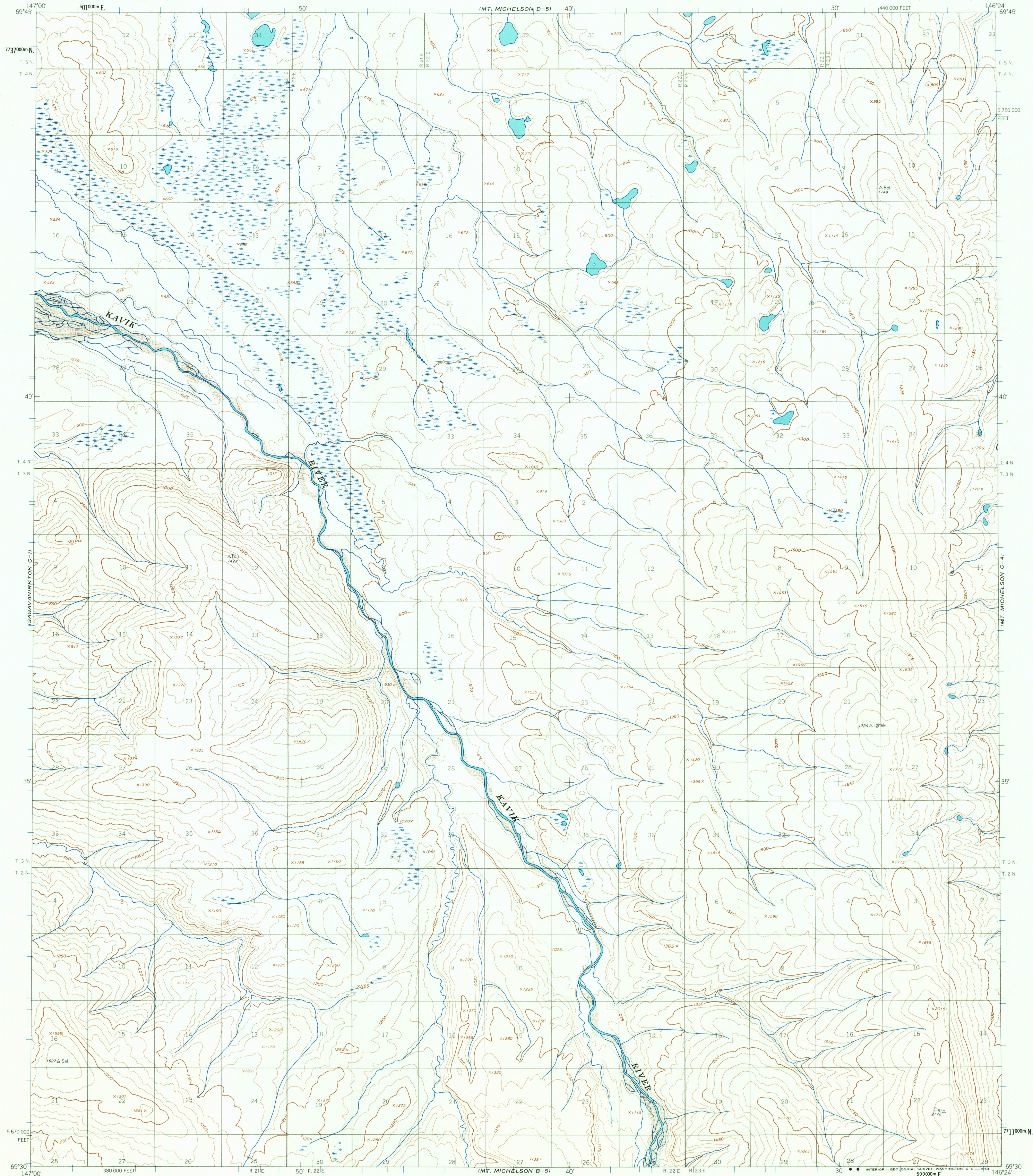

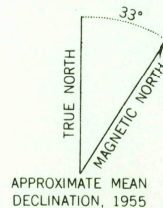
MT. MICHELSON (C-5) QUADRANGLE

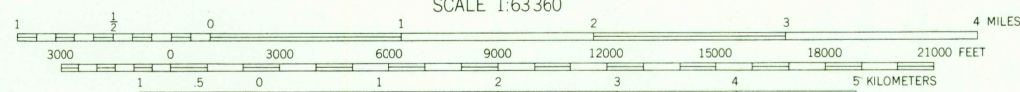
