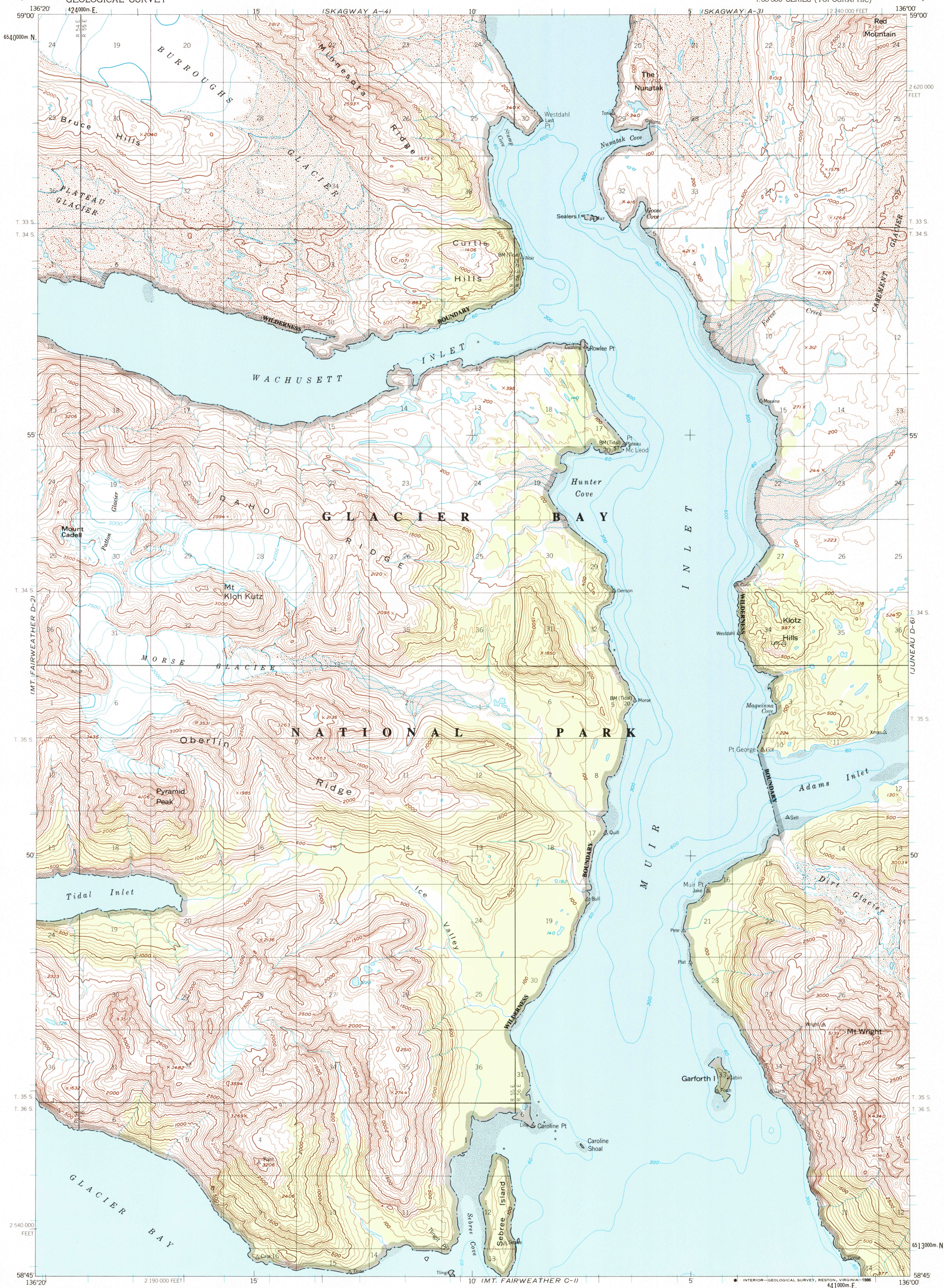

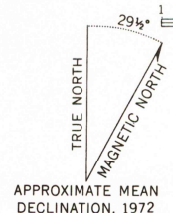
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 38 meters north and 104 meters east
