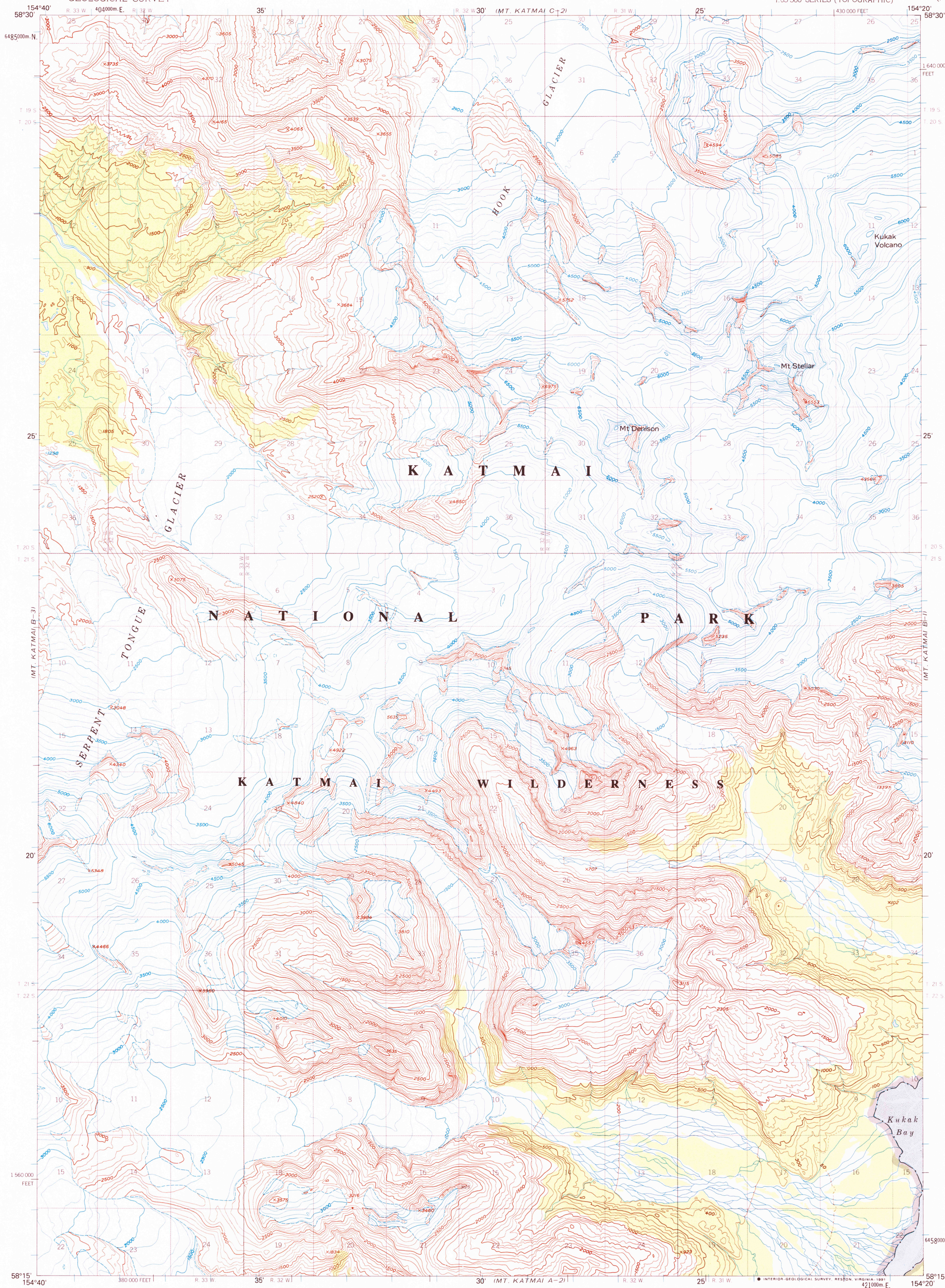

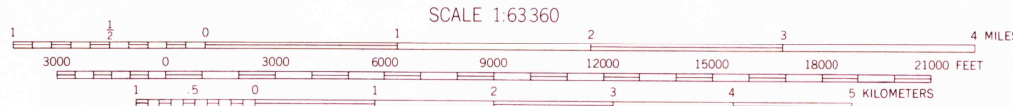
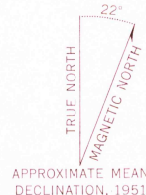
MT. KATMAI (B-2). QUADRANGLE
