

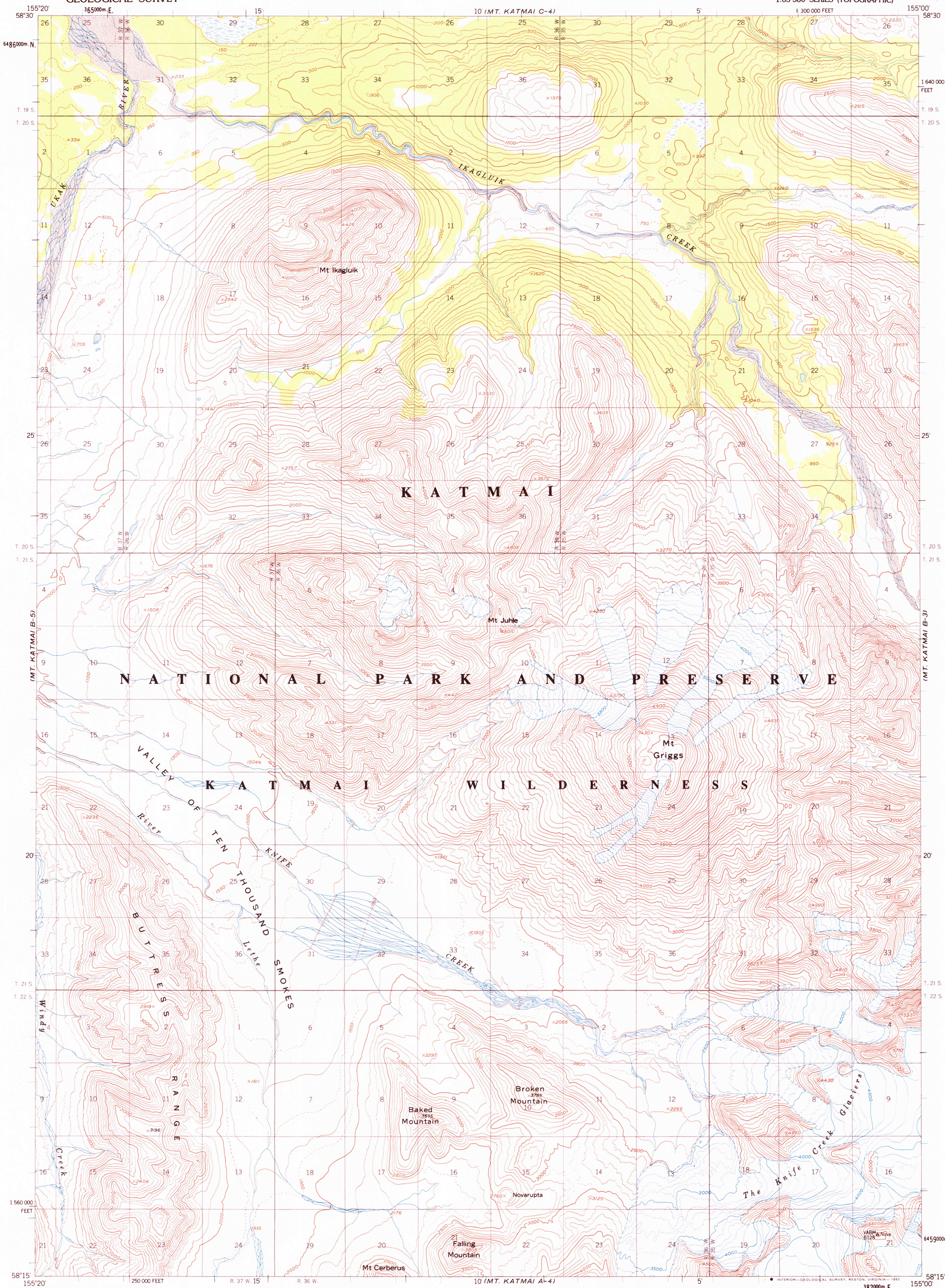

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 5, shown in blue

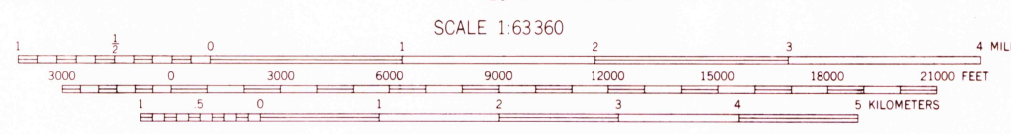
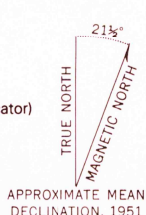
