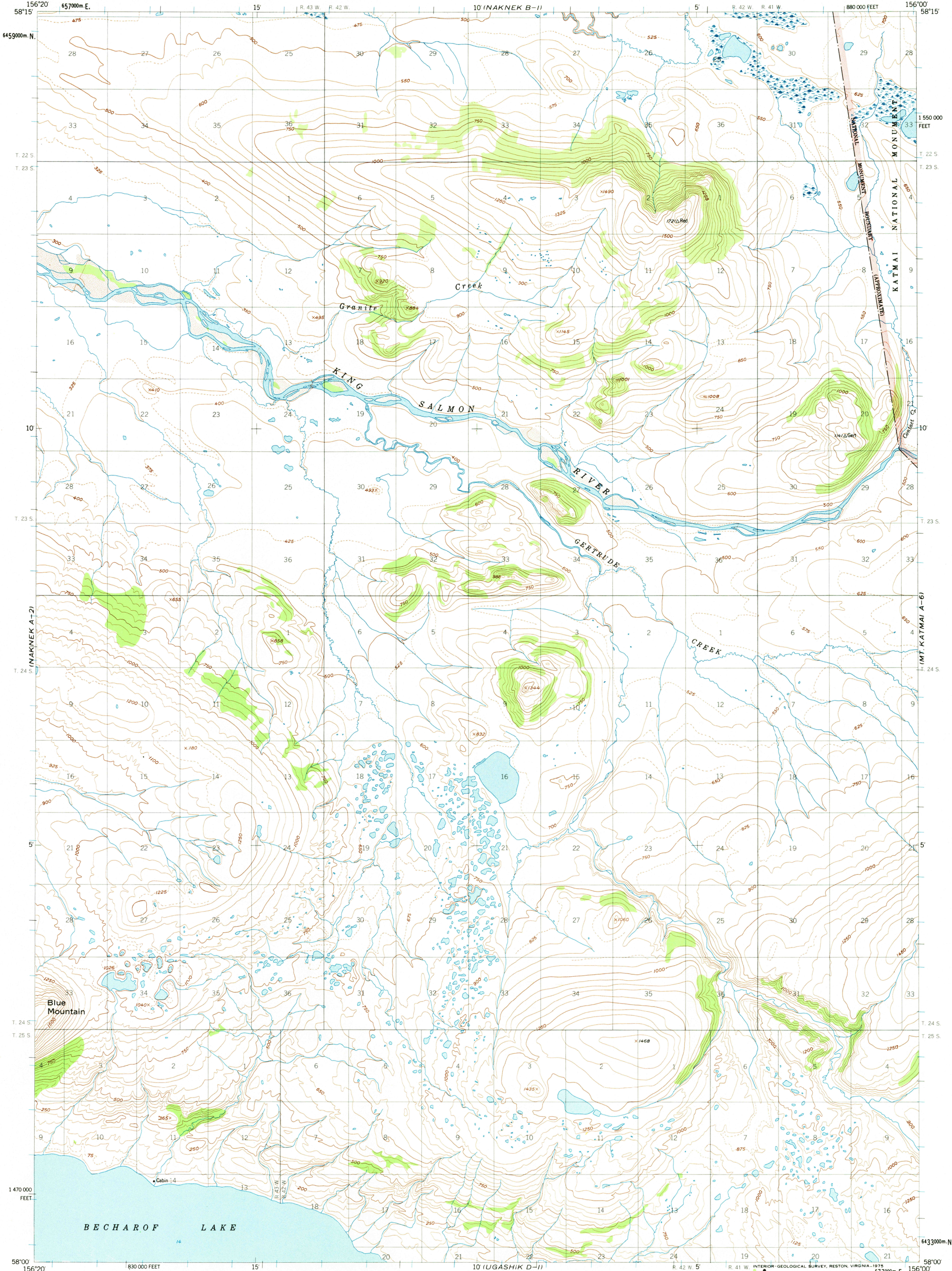

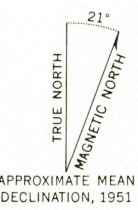
NAKNEK (A-1) QUADRANGLE
