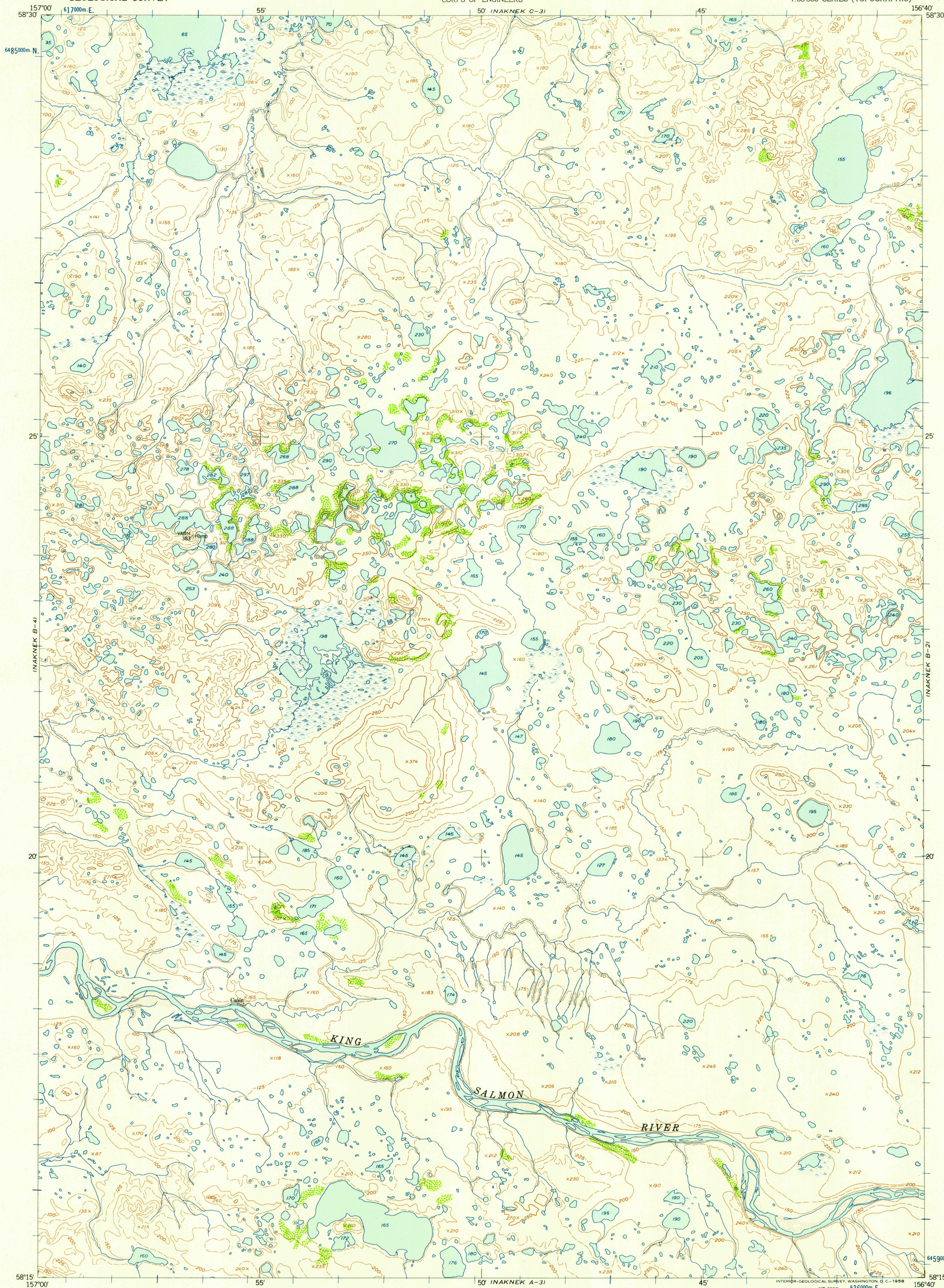

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown and blue

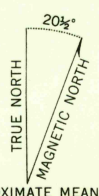

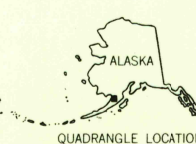
