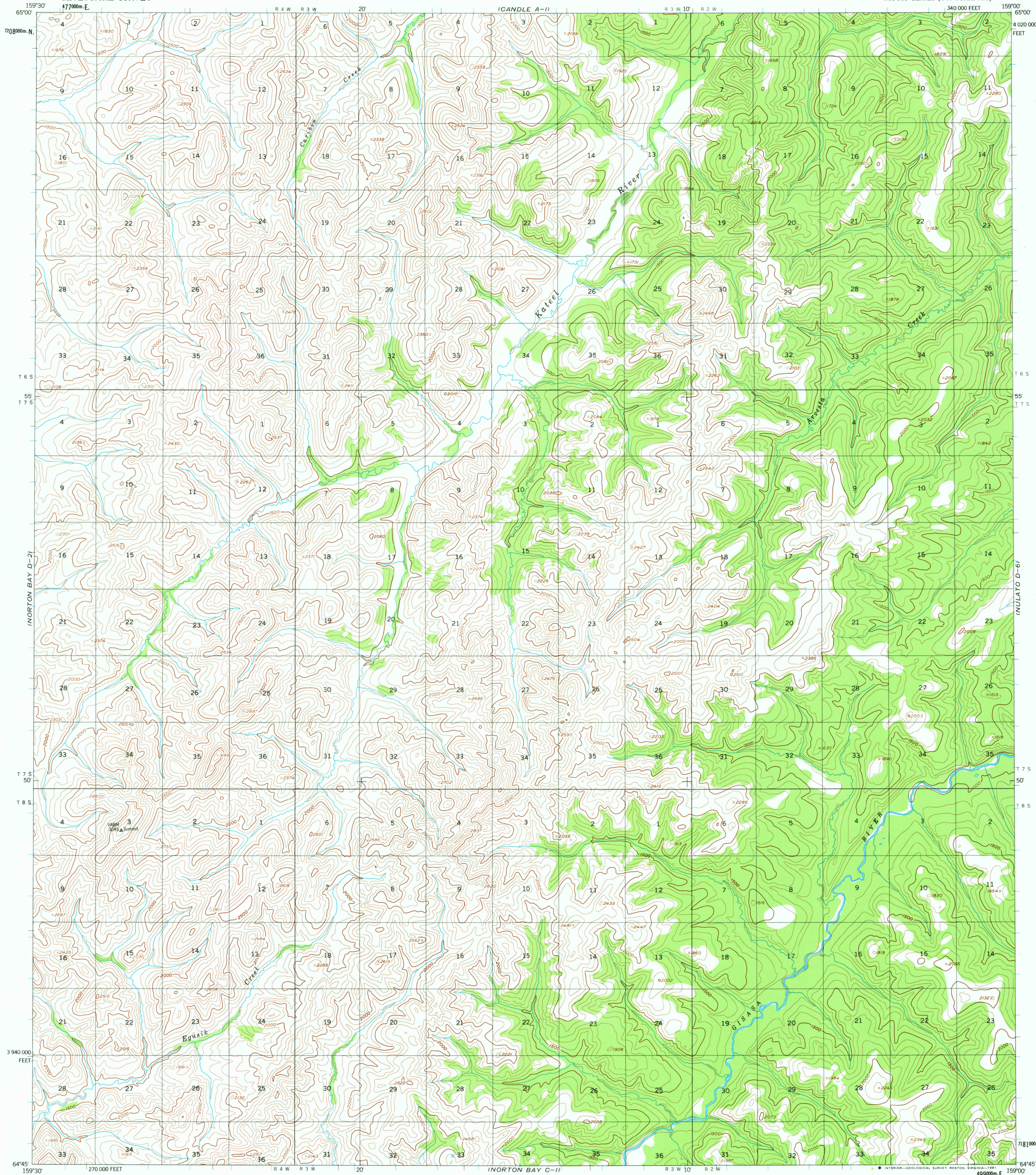

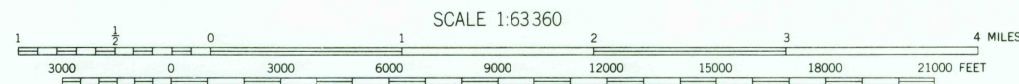
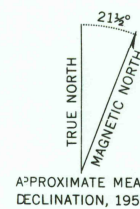

Universal Transverse Mercator projection, 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 6 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 4, shown in blue

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-12, Seward Meridian

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 75 meters north and 124 meters east
