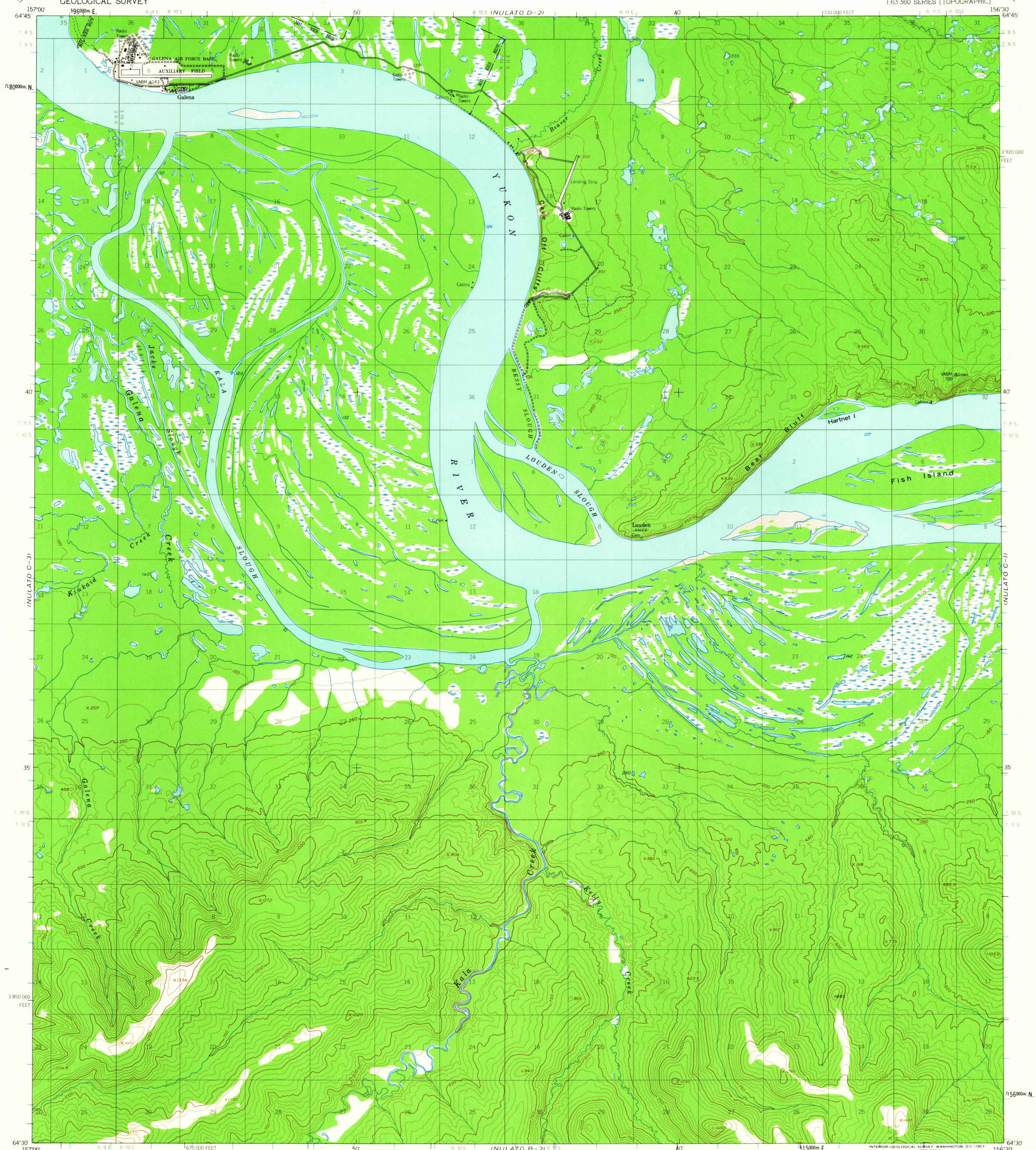

zone 4, shown in blue

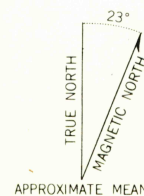

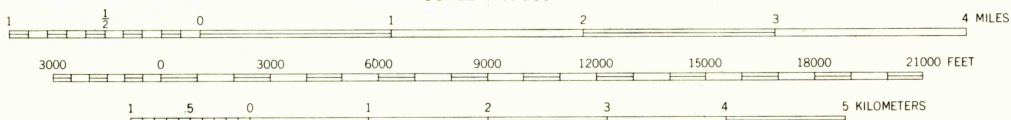
Folio K 11, Keteel River Meridian
