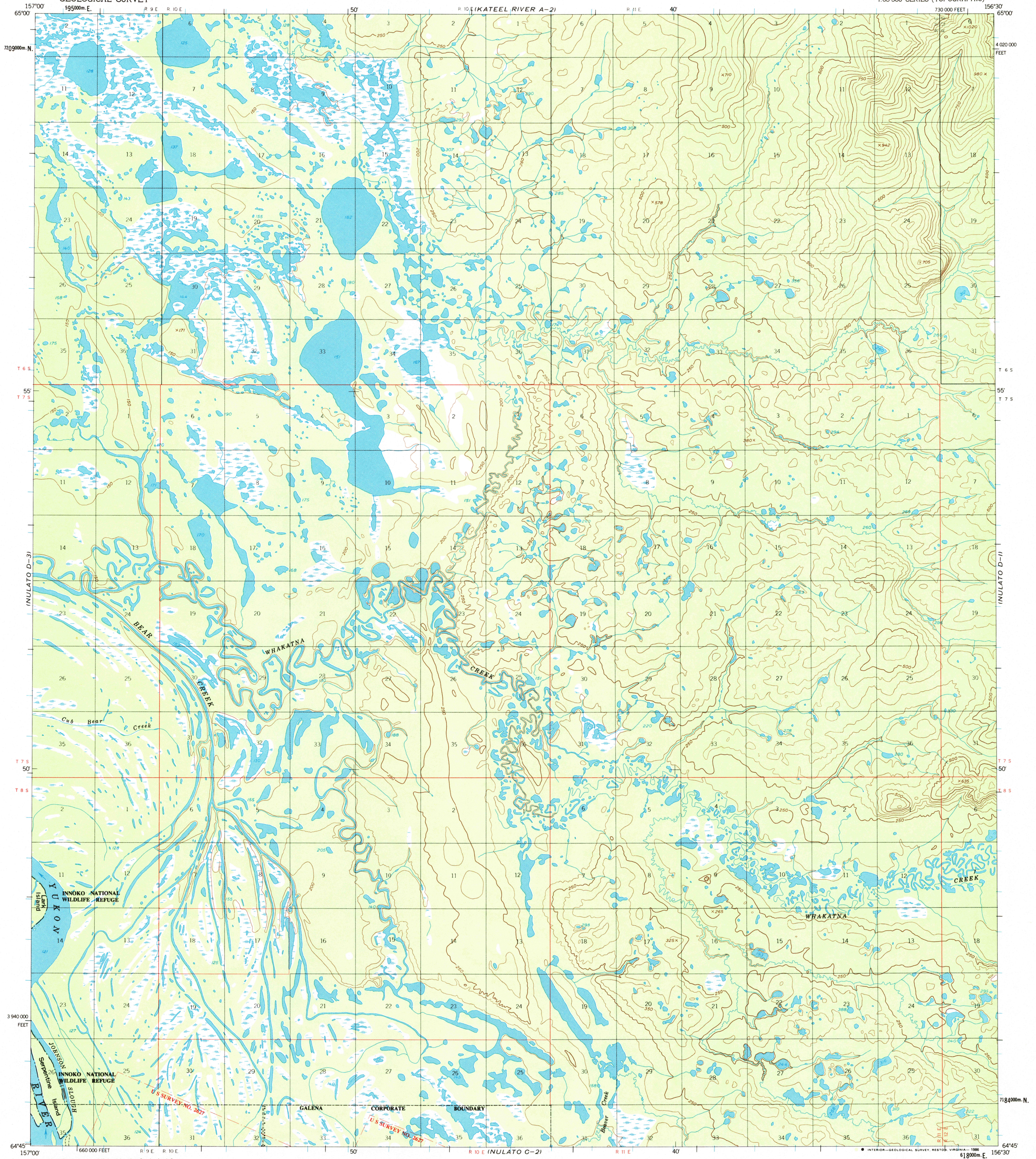

the projection lines 71 meters north and 121 meters east

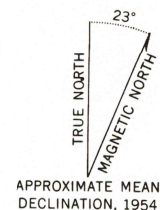

Folio K-11, Kateel River Meridian

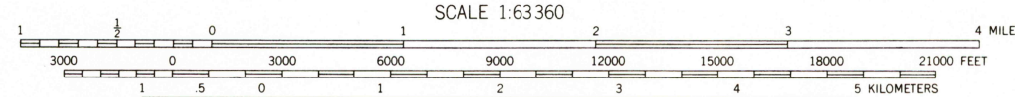
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
