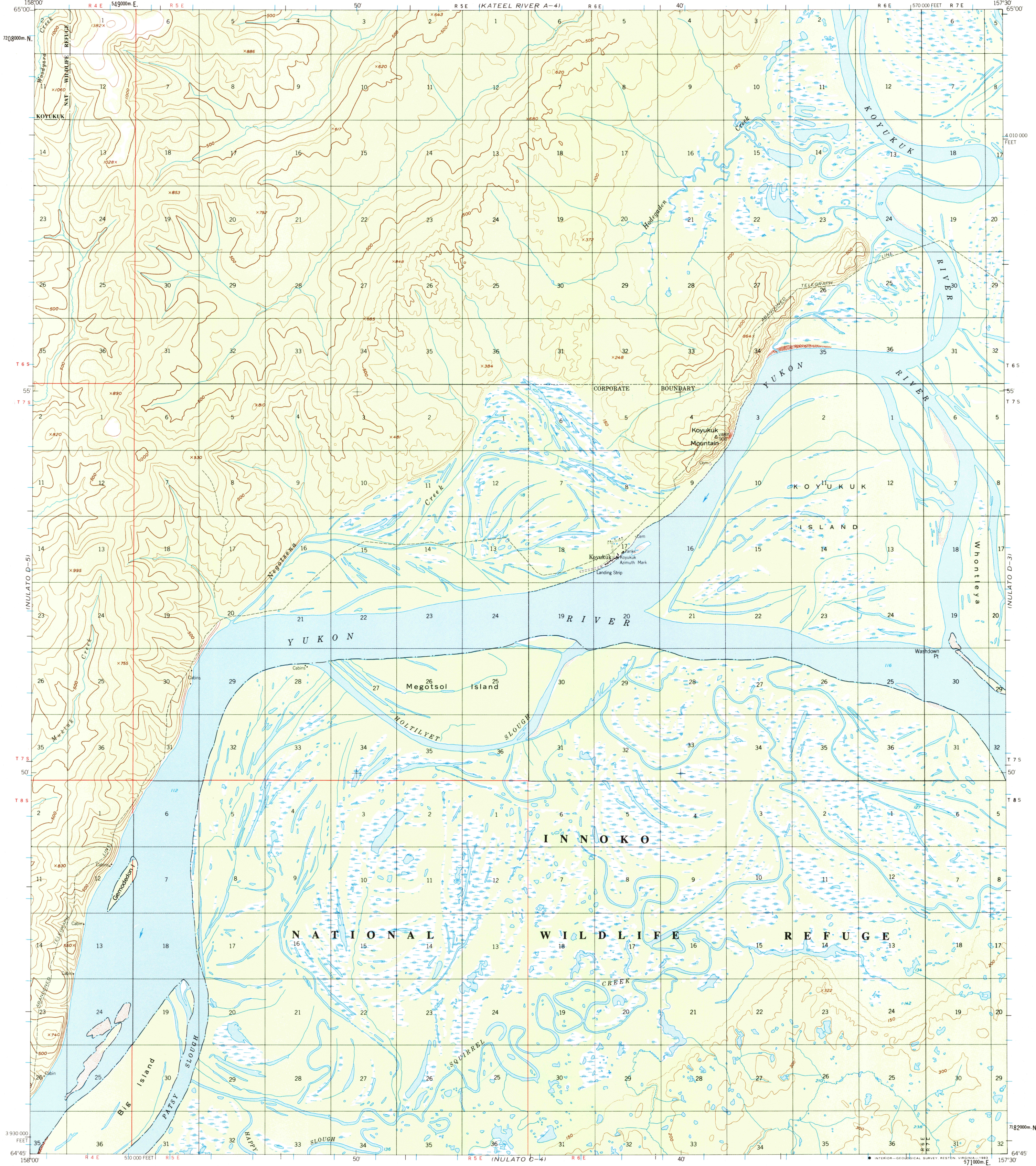

zone 6. 1927 North American datum

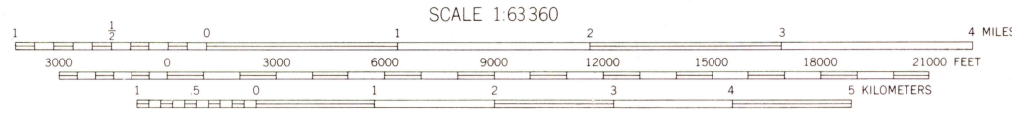
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
