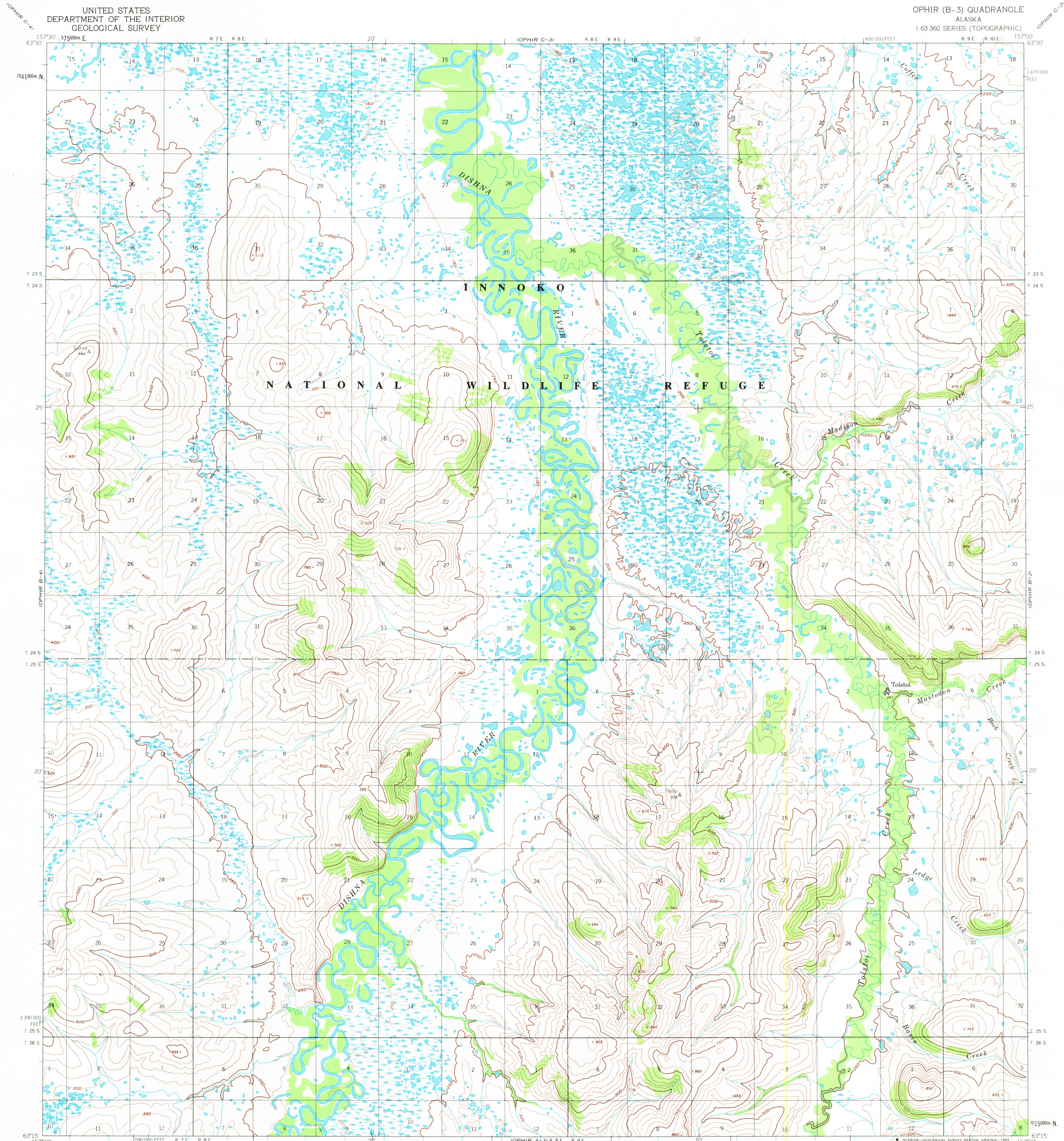
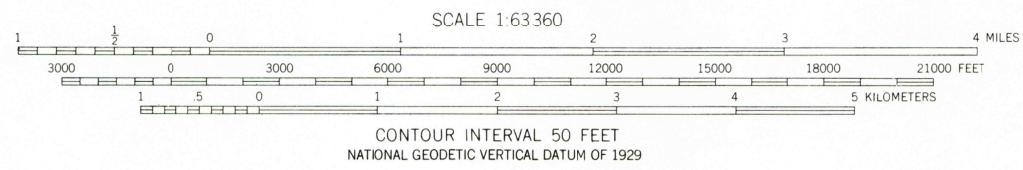
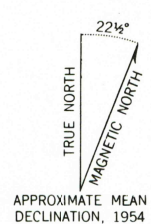




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Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1953, 1955 and 1957, field annotated 1954. Map not field checked
